### Problems of Profession Topic of Nurse Workshop

"Your Job and You" was the theme of the two-day workshop sponsored by District 4 of the Oregon Nurses' association which opened Wednesday, April 15 at 1 p.m. in the Red Cross building.

The keynote address on "The What, Why and How of the Economic Security Program for Nurses" was given by Mrs. Mathilda Young, R. N., Seattle, who is vice chairman of the American Nurses' association committee on economic security.

"No nurse can give nursing care of the best quality if she is harassed by insecurity and the resultant inability to lead a satisfactory personal life," Mrs. Young declared. "In addition to an adequate salary she needs recognition of her abilities and worth. She needs incentives to remain and grow in the job in the form of tenure and merit increases, adequate vacation, health protection and provision for retirement.

"Because the rule of the nurse is becoming increasingly complex as medical and social sciences advance, the nurse must keep herself equipped with the knowledge and skills essential to perfect the art of nursing. To do this she needs time for educational pursuits and participation in professional activities.

"In order to fulfill its obligation to society, the nursing profession must attract and hold young men and women possessed of vision, intelligence and potential for the development of a high degree of nursing skills, as well as a deep desire to be of service," she added.

**Nurses Believe**  
Freedom to participate in formulating conditions of em-

ployment, is as important as freedom of religion, speech and press, it was said. This also affects the ill person in that these conditions are reflected in the care rendered him. "This workshop has provided nurses with an opportunity to study and work together on problems of employment conditions, recruitment, professional status and nursing care," Mrs. Young pointed out. "This helps meet the serious challenges facing the nursing profession today, nurses are seeking ways to increase the public's understanding of and help in solving some of the problems," she concluded.

Also speaking at the workshop were Mrs. Evelyn Conner, Portland, president of Oregon Nurses' association; Mrs. Bertha Byrne, Portland, executive secretary of Oregon Nurses' association and Miss Nora Marco, Portland, associate executive secretary of ONA.

Mrs. Martha Donahue was chairman for a skit entitled "To Each His Own" which was presented Wednesday evening. The object of the skit was to show how each nurse in her own field assists in caring for an individual patient.

The patient was first cared for by the general duty nurse, then a private duty nurse and finally by the public health nurse with help from a social worker in solving the problem of assistance after hospital dismissal.

Guest speakers were Dr. Alvin Roberts, Central Point, the Rev. E. S. Tollefson, of the Ascension Lutheran church and Miss Nora Marco, who represented the social worker in her absence.
