

Four Appear in Circuit Court

The case of Victor Borkowski, 47, of the Jackson hotel, Medford, has been continued in Jackson county circuit court pending an FBI report.

Borkowski Friday pleaded guilty to charges of uttering and publishing a false check. Jack Wilcox, 5310 Highway 66, Ashland, appeared before Judge Edward Kelly Friday on violation of probation. He is to be reinstated on probation and was returned in custody pending further investigation of placing him in Nebraska.

Wilcox, who was originally placed on probation for burglary not in a dwelling, was charged with violating his probation by using intoxicating liquors, frequenting an improper place for amusement and taking internally contents of a nasal inhaler, according to court records.

Fred Lee Hickey, 22, of general delivery, Medford, waived privilege of having a grand jury, was arraigned on district attorney's information charging grand larceny and Cliff D. Ouellette, Medford, was appointed his attorney. Hickey is charged with taking a 1949 Mercury sedan owned by Huffman auto and truck parts, Medford, on April 12. He appeared before Circuit Judge James Main on charges of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He was arraigned on district attorney's information and Walter D. Nunley was appointed his attorney.

Flag Service for Merchants Started

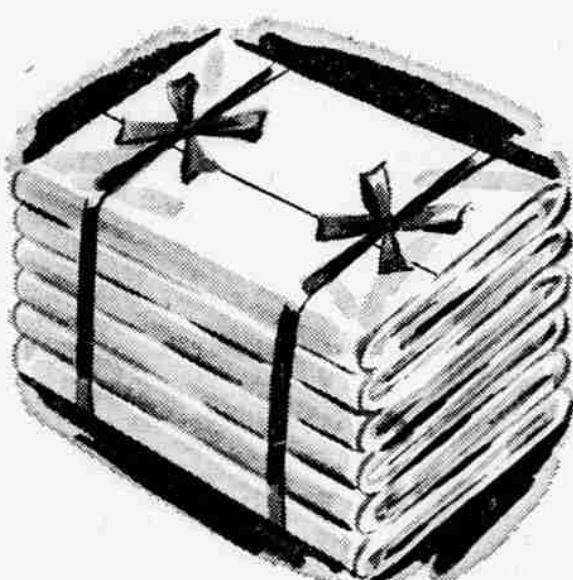

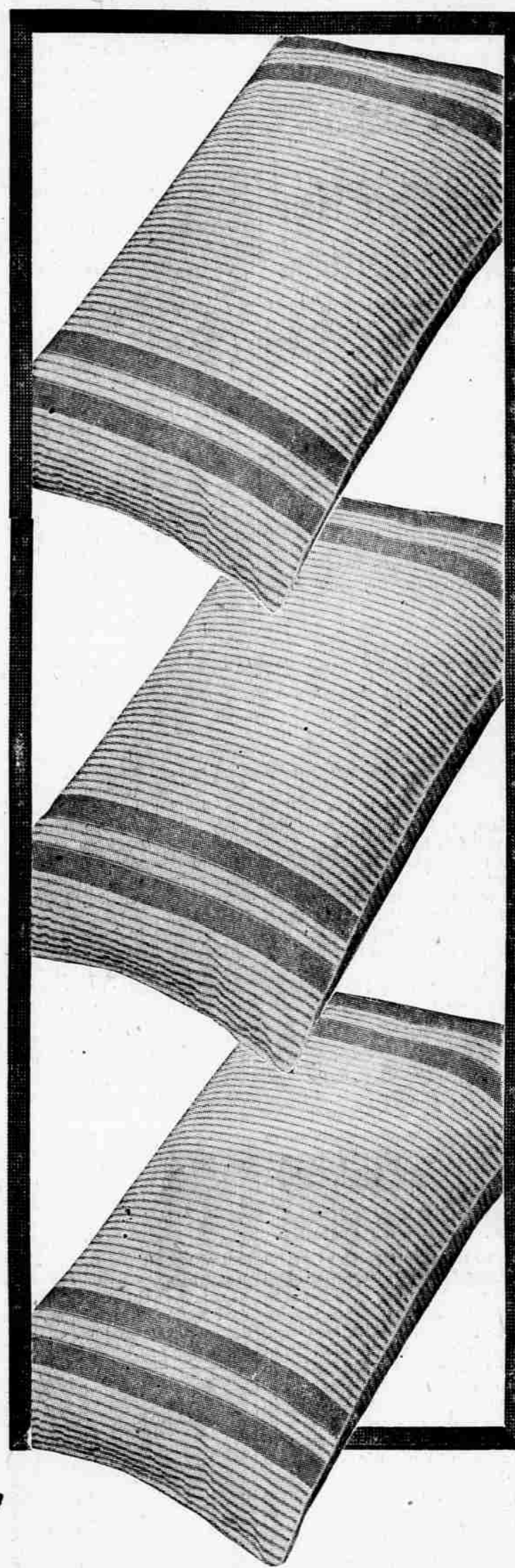

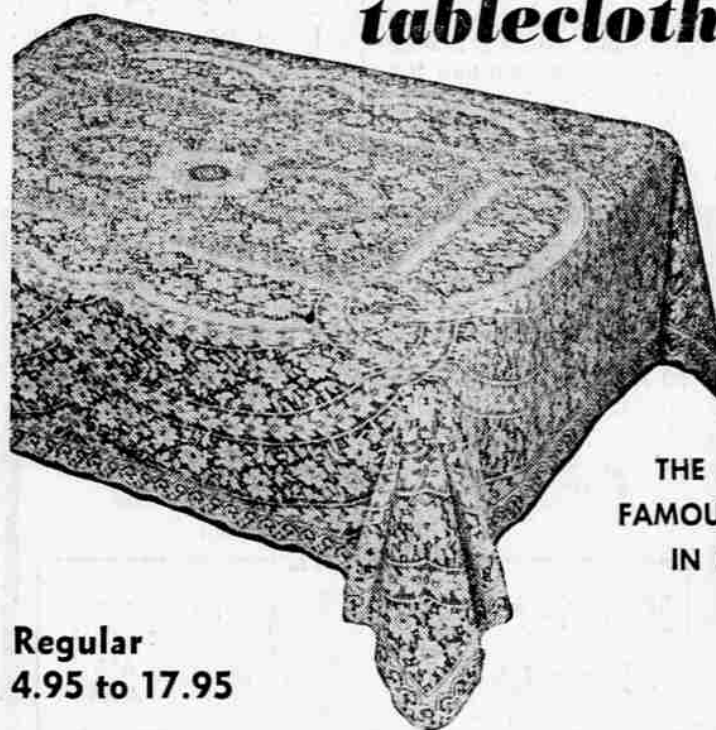
