

Federal Aid to Education Bill Would Let State Choose Uses

Washington - The state of Oregon would be eligible for \$1,250,000 a year in federal aid for education under a new bill favorably reported out of a House Education subcommittee.

The proposed legislation would let the state decide whether to apply the federal funds to school construction needs or for teacher salaries, or both.

"The purpose is to build classrooms and aid teachers," declared Rep. Cleveland Bailey (D-W.Va.), subcommittee chairman. "We are not concerned how the state uses it. We are not meddling in state affairs. We are just giving them a grant of money. That's the beauty of this proposal, its simplicity."

For Four Years

The legislation would authorize the aid program for four years starting July 1, 1959. Total cost is estimated at \$4.4 billion for that period. The basic formula for allocating funds among the states would be to provide \$25 for each child between ages 5 and 17 residing in the state. All the children would not

have to be attending public schools for the state to claim them in determining its share. It would be up to each state to determine, as they do now, whether to provide any aid to non-public schools.

Compared to Oregon's \$11,250,000, Washington state would be entitled to \$17,675,000, Idaho would get \$4,525,000, California would get \$87,800,000, and Alaska \$1,380,000.

Final Hearings

The Senate Education and Labor committee has just finished its hearings on aid to education legislation but has not yet indicated the type of bill it will report out.

The bill emerging from the House subcommittee is a modification of a proposal advanced by the National Education association. The original version would have provided for a permanent program under which the government would offer each state \$100 per school age child annually.

The trimmed-down version is an attempt at working out a compromise which might have a better chance of being enacted and signed into law by President Eisenhower. The Administration has not asked Congress for any sort of school aid legislation this year, as was done in previous years.

Also, a modest bill stands

a better chance of being enacted now during continuing concern over balancing the federal budget. Placing a four-year time limit on the program is expected to give the character of an emergency program rather than a permanent one.

Republican opposition is already showing itself to the

modified bill. The subcommittee vote reporting out the bill was along party lines, four Democrats favoring it, two Republicans opposing. Democrats dominate the full committee 20-10, so they have the votes if it comes to a party line test.

One major obstacle is the House Rules committee, which is conservative in its

makeup on both sides of the party fence. The Rules committee would have to clear the bill before it could come up for House debate.

Classroom Need

Rep. Edith Green (D-Ore.), a committee member, believes there is strong public support now for federal aid to educa-

tion because of the need for more classrooms in most communities.

The administration's viewpoint was expressed by Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare Arthur S. Flemming: "The proper role of the federal government in the educational field is to pinpoint what I would call emergency

Waterways Growth Noted

Walla Walla, Wash. - (UPI) - Increase in construction or expansion of industrial plants and waterside facilities was not noted along the Nation's inland waterways in 1958 and particularly on the Columbia river, Herbert C. West, executive vice president of the Inland Empire Waterways association, said here yesterday.

Last year the Boise Cascade Corp. built a pulp and paper mill on the Columbia river near Walla Walla, and construction of a new chemical plant by California Spray Co. at Kennewick was announced.

At Portland, the commission of public docks is constructing a bulk cargo pier at cost of \$3,700,000, and at Wallula, Columbia Grain and Storage is building a \$250,000 elevator plant.

West said the figures were quoted in a survey released by the American Waterways Operators, Inc.
