

## Truman To Lecture At Columbia U.

New York — (UPI) — Former President Harry S. Truman, who has "no degree except those I didn't earn," begins a three-day series of lectures to college students today on a subject he knows better than most professors — the U.S. government — the U.S. government.

Truman promised he'd talk plain language, as usual, to Columbia University students, "I'm no college professor," he said on his arrival here.

Sunday with Mrs. Truman. "I'm going to deliver lectures to these kids as I've been doing ever since I left the White House. I'll try to explain what we have and how to keep it."

Truman, delivering the inaugural William Radner Lectures on public law and government, will lecture today on "The Presidency," Tuesday on "The Constitution" and Wednesday on "Hysteria."

Recently, Dr. P. Connell of England, reported 42 cases of psychosis or mental aberration, due to the taking of amphetamine. Eight of the patients became deranged after taking just one dose. In some cases the patient became violently homicidal.
