German Measles in Early Pregnancy

Today, many mothers are worrying because, during their pregnancy, they suffered an attack of German measles. Some of them can be greatly reassured because they had the measles late in their pregnancy when the little one was so well-formed that no serious harm could come to him or her. In England, the ministry of health commissioned Drs. Jackson and Fisch to make a study of children who were born of mothers who had German measles during the first 16 weeks of pregnancy. The report is in the London Lancet. Fifty-seven such children were found, and 30 per cent were found to have been born more or less deaf. Fortunately, the deafness was only on one side in one-third of the children affected. If a pregnant mother should get German measles in the first few weeks of pregnancy, she should be given gamma globulin.

Strokes in the Young

In a recent article, Dr. H. Stevens of Lancaster, Penna., reported 32 cases in which a healthy young person without a high blood pressure suffered a decided stroke. In all these cases the stroke came out of a clear sky, just as it does in the case of an older person. Fortunately, in most of the cases the paralysis tended to clear up. In many, the cause probably was the presence at birth of a number of tiny aneurysms, or little weak places in the wall of one of the big arteries at the base of the brain.
