Local Youth Takes College Fellowship

Jerry Peterson, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Peterson, 1440 Whitman ave., Medford, has accepted a research teaching fellowship at Columbia university, according to reports from Oregon State college in Corvallis, from which he was graduated last year.

The fellowship offer resulted from Peterson's successful research in the field of heat transfer. His work has been classified as a "breakthrough in the field of heat transfer which will make possible smaller nuclear reactors."

At Columbia, he will teach classes and construct a nuclear reactor while working on his master's degree. He plans to work toward a doctorate later. He majored in chemical engineering at Oregon State.

66 German Measles Cases Reported

Sixty-six cases of German measles were reported in Jackson county last week, according to Dr. A. Erin Merkel, public health physician. Forty-eight cases were reported in Medford, 8 in Phoenix, 6 in Central Point and 4 in Ashland.

Other cases of communicable diseases were pneumonia, 4 in Ashland, 2 in Medford and Camp White and 1 in Butte Falls; amoebic dysentery, Phoenix 1; measles, Medford 12, Ashland 7, and Trail 1; and chicken pox, Medford 11, Applegate 4, and Ashland 1.

SP Switching in Grants Pass Moves

Grants Pass - Southern Pacific railroad late last week shifted most of its switching operations out of the downtown Grants Pass business area.

G. M. Joyce, Medford, trainmaster in charge of SP operations in southern Oregon, and J. M. Wilson, Glendale, roadmaster in charge of construction and relocation, made the announcement.

The move to switching outside the downtown area was made before SP had completed construction of its new switching yards east of Grants Pass. They said the second new yard track, with a capacity of 65 freight cars, would be placed in service, bringing new yard capacity up to 125 cars. When the third yard track is completed, the total will be about 185 cars, they added.

The changeover involves all switching operations formerly handled in the downtown yards, Joyce said. The company will continue to weigh cars at the present scales downtown because new scales are not yet completed.

The three new switching tracks will extend from just east of Mill st. for about three fourths of a mile to a point at the Ament Dam rd. crossing the main line.

Some maps cost up to \$20,000 even before they are sent to the printers. One Baton Rouge oil spokesman said that much money was spent to make sure the maps were kept up to date with the latest road changes. Some of the larger oil companies here provide as many as 60 different maps. Others in coastal areas publish marine maps showing water depths, water routes, buoys, compass check points, and other details for the sea-faring motorist.

Registrations Open For Swim Classes

Registrations are now being accepted at the Medford Young Men's Christian association for swimming lessons for persons 6 years old and older. Robert L. Jones, general secretary, has announced.

Jones pointed out that learning to swim well is one of the most important water safety rules. He reviewed water safety rules in view of the coming swimming season in the area's streams and lakes.

In addition to learning to swim well, he said, a life guard should always be present, and warning signs should be obeyed. Among other water safety rules are the dangers of swimming in seaweed, overexertion, knowing the current of a stream and the water's depth.

Keeping calm during an emergency is the best policy, Jones said, and all swimmers should know how to revive a person through artificial respiration.

Jones noted that last year, 478,327 persons were taught to swim in YMCA pools throughout the country. Information on the local swimming instructions may be obtained from the YMCA office, SP 2-6295.
