

## Klamath Falls Man Hurt in Accident

A Klamath Falls man escaped serious injury in an early morning crash Thursday on Old Pacific highway near Talent, according to state police.

The man, George Keith Shelton, 21, was traveling south, police reported, when his car failed to make a curve. The vehicle skidded 471 feet on the east shoulder of the highway, knocking down several mail boxes, milk platforms and a fence before turning over into a Talent irrigation district ditch.

Police reported that Shelton escaped through the broken windshield and was taken to a nearby house. The car was badly damaged.

Officials reported that the incident is still under investigation.
