Funeral services for James C. Trammell, 60, of route 1, box 264, Gold Hill, who died Friday, will be held Wednesday at 1:30 p.m. in the Conger-Morris Funeral home. The Rev. Perry Johnson of the First Baptist church will officiate. Committal will be in Siskiyou Memorial park.

Mr. Trammell was born Aug. 23, 1898, in Hillsboro, Tex. He married Miss Ragna Lutz on May 6, 1951, at Las Vegas, Nev. He had lived in the Gold Hill area for the past three years.

Surviving are his wife, Ragna; two brothers, John Trammell and Dean Trammell, both of Bakersfield, Calif.; and two sisters, Mrs. Mildred Hanks of Oklahoma City, Okla., and Mrs. Lucille Pritchett of Dallas, Tex.

To Wake Island
Mr. Trammell together with 1,710 other men left San Francisco for Wake Island on Sept. 17, 1941, to construct air bases and buildings on Wake island. At noon on Dec. 8, 1941, following the attack on Pearl Harbor, the Japanese started their attack on Wake Island. The battle lasted until Dec. 23.

There they remained with Mr. Trammell remained a prisoner on Wake island until Jan. 12, 1942, then he and 871 other men were taken via Yokohama, Japan, to Shanghai, China, arriving there on Feb. 1, 1942.

Several of the prisoners who were with him on Wake island will attend the service.

Irrigation Water In Bear Creek Said Source of Pollution

Gerow noted that according to past surveys Bear creek has an ample supply of oxygen. This, he said, assures it "some recoverability" with respect to pollution abatement.

Replying to criticism of slaughter houses that dump wastes into Bear creek, Gerow stated that while these operations are a definite detriment aesthetically and "should be eliminated," they do not cause a "significant depreciation of the oxygen balance." He said that return water from irrigation ditches, with human and barnyard wastes, has proved a greater pollution factor than was originally thought.

Warned Against Ditches
Dr. A. Erin Merkel, Jackson county public health officer, said people are warned against using the creek for swimming or even wading. Gerow stated after the meeting that because of inevitable pollution from the irrigation ditches and other drainage, Bear creek will never be fit for swimming.

Dr. Merkel stressed that pollutants entering the creek are legion and originate from
