

11 Entries Foreseen in Preakness

Baltimore, Md. (UPI)—Tommy Lee, the Kentucky Derby winner, will be missing but eight horses which chased him home and three newcomers are expected to comprise a field of 11 today when the entries for Saturday's \$150,000 added Preakness Stake close.

Open View, the ruffian who rucked up the start of the Derby, already was entered when racing secretary Charles McLennan accepted entries for the second jewel in racing's triple crown.

Trainer Ray Metcalf paid the \$500 entry fee for Open View Thursday because he had to be at Garden State park today with the rest of Etkam Stable horses. Karl Kort is jockey.

With 11 starters the 83rd edition of the Maryland classic will be worth a total of \$190,300 with a net winner's purse of \$136,200 for all except Manassa Mauler.

Manassa Mauler, winner of the Wood Memorial at odds of 64 to 1, was not among the original 138 nominations for the Preakness. He was made eligible by payment of a \$10,000 supplementary nomination fee. He shoots for a net purse of \$126,300.

Sword Dancer, who apparently had the Kentucky Derby won when he went past Tommy Lee high on the turn into the stretch and again when he led by a length with only 50 yards to go, looms as favorite for the Preakness.

This time Willie Shoemaker, who was up on the victorious Tommy Lee at Louisville, rides Sword Dancer, who was 2 to 1 in the overnight line.

Eddie Arcaro, Preakness champion with six winners, shoots for No. 7 with First Landing, with Willie Harman on Royal Orbit, Ray Broussard on Manassa Mauler, Chris Rogers on Rico Tesio, Larry Adams on Sundown II and Willie Carstens on Festival King.

The jockeys for Dunc, Our Dad and Marauder were indefinite as their owners and trainers scrambled for the best riders available.

First Landing, the juvenile champion of 1958 when he won six stakes and a record \$396,460, is second choice at 3 to 1 with Royal Orbit third choice at 9 to 2.

Aaron Enjoys Typical Night As Braves Edge SL Cardinals

Stop Hank Aaron!
That's the watchword now among batters, bewildered National League pitchers who are worriedly wondering if there's any end in sight.

Aaron, currently on a 19-game hitting streak, is batting a fantastic .487 and shows no sign of letting up.

The pitchers used to say that no one ever would top Hugh Duffy's record, 438 set with the Boston Braves in 1894, but now they're beginning to think Aaron has a crack at it.

The 25-year-old Milwaukee mauler enjoyed one of his typical nights Thursday night when he collected three-for-five in an 8-7 victory over the St. Louis Cardinals that stretched the Braves' lead to 1 1/2 games.

Burdette Saves Game
Aaron's third hit, his second double of the game in the sixth inning, was the one that hurt the Cards. It came with the bases full and capped a five-run rally. Lew Burdette came in from the bullpen to throttle a three-run ninth-inning St. Louis rally and preserve Bob Rush's third victory.

Pittsburgh defeated Los Angeles 7-6; San Francisco blanked Philadelphia, 8-0.
