The Family Council

Editor's note: The Family Council consists of a judge, a psychiatrist, three clergymen, a newspaper editor, a woman's editor and two writers. Each article is a summary of an actual report. The Family Council does not give advice; it merely reports on problems that have been dealt with by responsible agencies and counselors.

Miriam T. — Sometimes I think I don't love him any more. Ronald T. — I would do anything to make her happy.

Miriam T. — My husband and I were married a year ago after a courtship of six years. I was terribly in love with him and I couldn't give him up even though he told me time and time again that he liked me very much but was not in love with me.

During the years we went together, Ronny took up with a lot of different girls, but he always got bored with them after a while and came back to me. At last he agreed that we must be destined for each other. The funny thing is that after looking forward to marriage to him for so many years, I find it nowhere near as exciting as I had imagined. I have no complaints against Ronny. He is as sweet and considerate as he can be, but sometimes I think I don't love him any more.

Ronald T. — Our relationship has really been very strange. I never seriously expected to marry Miriam until the end even though she always kept saying it was in the cards for us.

Now that we are married and I realize what a wonderful person Miriam is I only regret all the time I wasted running around with other girls. I feel now that I am really in love with her and would do anything to make her happy. But I know that she has not been very happy since we've been married. It bothers me that Miriam doesn't have the same interest and enthusiasm she used to bring to everything before our marriage. She always used to think of interesting places to go and was constantly whipping up something special to do.

The Council: When someone who has had enthusiasm for life suddenly loses it, the possibility of a physical cause should always be looked into. Nutritional deficiency or glandular trouble can wreck marriages as effectively as psychological causes. Barring the possibility of a physical cause, it sounds as though Miriam has been plumb tuckered out by her long race after Ronald. After so many years of it, the race became a thing in itself for her and she forgot all about

the goal. With no running to do, she feels as though there is nothing for her any more. It is also possible that Miriam is the kind of person who enjoys a challenge more than anything else. She should recognize, however, that there is still a big challenge before here—that of making her marriage a success. It calls for at least as much ingenuity as capturing a mate. There is the same need to find new sources of interest and enjoyment. Miriam should be aware that she could emotionally lose the man she has fought so hard to win.

We could say that she may be the kind of person who can only care for someone who does not love her, but the fact that her husband now finds her "wonderful" and enjoys married life is an indication that she must be giving warmth and affection. Unfortunately, she seems to place less value on this than she did on the excitement of the chase. Perhaps she merely needs to make some shift in the way she looks at things. If she fully believes that companionship and closeness with her husband are among the best things in life, she will feel happier knowing that she has them.
