Gasoline Dealers Threaten Closure

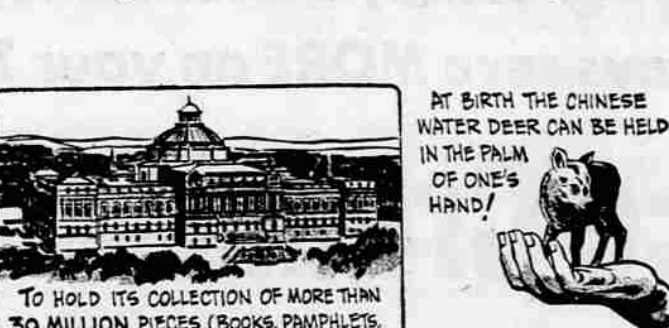
Salem - (UPI) - Unless oil companies allow more profit, mid-Willamette valley gasoline dealers will follow the lead of their state organization which decided last week on a two-day Memorial Day week end shutdown in western Oregon.

The mid-valley decision was made in a meeting of 62 dealers at Dallas this week. Representatives from Woodburn, Silverton, Mill City and Albany as well as Salem were represented.

The state association seeks an end to a smoldering price war, removal of all subsidies and stabilization of tank-wagon load discounts.
