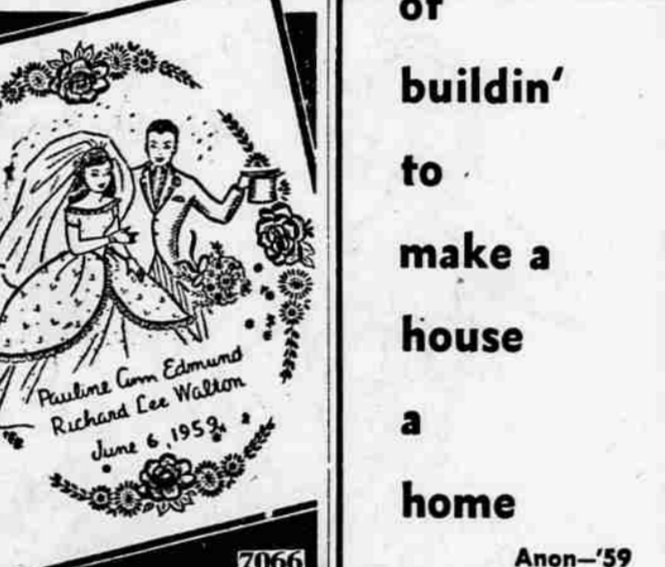
As the disappointed inventor was leaving, Twain asked, "What did you say your name was?" "Bell," answered the inventor sadly. "Alexander Graham Bell."

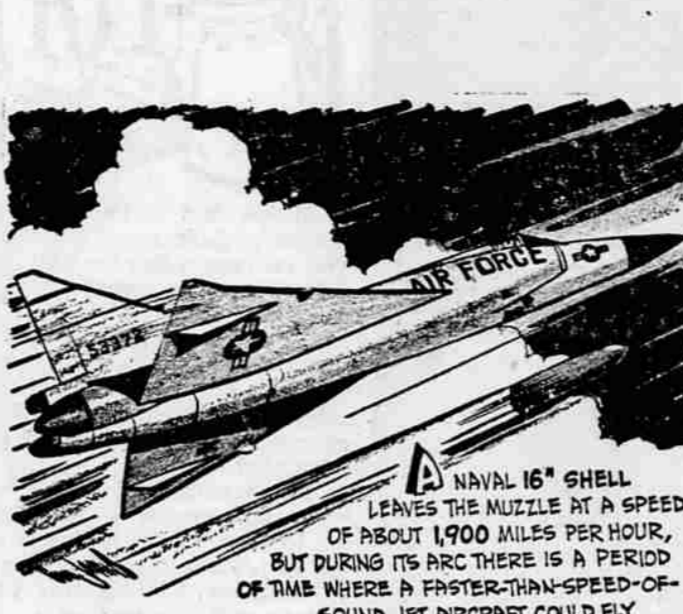
