Dr. Alvarez and gifted. Like many Americans, I have been disturbed over accusations made that our high schools are not doing a good job. Two important books on this subject have just appeared: one, which all of us should read, "The American High School Today," (McGraw-Hill) was written by the great educator, Dr. James B. Conant. Conant and four collaborators visited 103 high schools plus four city school systems in 26 states. They were trying to find out whether our schools are providing a good general education for all of the pupils so that they can eventually be good citizens. The investigators were looking, also, to see if the schools are providing good elective programs to help many of the students to acquire useful skills; and, finally, the investigators wanted to know if the schools are providing adequately for the education of those few youngsters who have a God-given gift for going ahead, perhaps in science or engineering or medicine.

Kampala, Uganda - (UP) - Uganda was under virtual martial law yesterday as the result of the crackdown on the native Uganda National Movement by Gov. Frederick Crawford to meet the threat of violence in this British protectorate in East Africa.

Crawford outlawed the national movement Friday night and declared all of Buganda "disturbed area." The action gave police extensive security powers against the possibility of civil disturbances.

Buganda, one of the four provinces of Uganda, is the home of some one million natives ruled by the Kakaka, Futesa II, or "king Freddie." "King Freddie" was flown into exile in England in 1955 on breaking political agreements with the British government but has been permitted to return to his throne.

The crackdown stemmed from what a government statement said was violence and intimidation connected with the boycott against non-African shops and goods by the movement. The statement said previous measures had proved ineffective.
