The state public utilities commission has approved requests by two White City firms. The Southern Oregon Moulding Incorporated had requested authority to impair standard railroad clearances at its lumber shed, factory building and loading docks at White City. The other request was made by the Cascade Wood Products for a similar request at its factory building and loading dock. It was explained that buildings and track were constructed during World War II and do not conform to the standard clearances of the PUC. Both companies are required to install impaired clearance signs. ## The Medical Roundup

### Bates' System of Eye Exercises

I am often distressed when I get letters from people who obviously ought to be under the care of an excellent ophthalmologist if they are to keep what little sight they have left. What frightens me is that some of these people are going to some quackish person who is giving them Bates' eye exercises so that "they can throw away their glasses." Since probably many of these people will not listen to my warning of great danger. I am repeating here a little of what one of England's greatest ophthalmologists, Sir Stewart Duke-Elder, had to say on the subject.

In volume IV of his famous Text-Book of Ophthalmology, he speaks of the foolishness of these eye exercises that are supposed to make it possible for people to throw away their glasses. As he says, the opportunity for teaching people to use these exercises has been seized upon with enthusiasm by unqualified persons; "but in order to make the rather tedious business of eye exercises more palatable, and their inherent simplicity sufficiently impressive to convert the credulous, an irrelevant and usually ridiculous pantomime of accessories has been added."

From letters I get I know that in this country there are hundreds of thousands of people who, without any knowledge of the complicated subject of the structure and mode of function of the eyes, feel that they are competent to decide to entrust their vision to some quackish person. Experts tell me that Bates' writings are so preposterous that he could not have known much about eyes. Those who may doubt my word on this should read several articles on Bates and his quackery that have been published during the last year in the "Sight-Saving Review."

This is published quarterly by The National Society for the Prevention of Blindness. Certainly, these people know what they are talking about, and their only concern in writing about Bates and his followers is to keep people from wasting their time on such foolishness until perhaps they go blind.

It is a remarkable fact that I get many letters a month from people with a serious eye condition who, when they are losing their sight, do not bother to see an ophthalmologist!

## Many Children Caring for Selves

Orono, Maine - (UPI) - Nearly 400,000 children in the United States under 12 have to care for themselves while their mothers work, and 138,000 of these children are less than 10 years of age.

Among those under 12, one child in 13 whose mother holds down a job must look out for himself for varying periods of time, said Dr. John G. Chantigny.

The extension service family life specialist at the University of Maine said that among youngsters 10 and 11, one in five goes without care while his mother is at work. The number of mothers in the labor force with children under 18 has more than doubled since 1950, Dr. Chantigny said.

During May, 1958, a total of 2,873,000 mothers were working full-time. They had 6,665,000 children, of whom 5,073,000 were under 12.
