**Plastic Garment  
Bag Maker Has  
Use Suggestions**

Kordite corporation has announced plans for a public education program to prevent further suffocation deaths to children from the plastic garment bags it manufactures.

Kordite, one of the largest bag makers, claims it is the first to undertake such a campaign.

The program includes supplying counter cards, and tags for garment hangers, "at no charge" to laundriers and to cleaners who use Kordite materials.

The cards and tags are to read, "Caution: for safety reasons keep plastic bags away from children as you would matches or medicines."

Howard Samuels, Kordite president, offered these suggestions for safe use of the bags:

**Suggestions**

"1. Keep the bags away from children.

"2. Treat the bags with the same respect accorded matches or cutlery.

"3. They're not toys—don't play with them!

"4. When the bags have outlived their sensible usefulness, destroy and throw them away.

"5. Never use a plastic bag as covering for a crib mattress.

"All of us are tremendously concerned," Samuels said, "over accidents that occur to young children. The death of even one child is a terrible tragedy and the number of these incidents is appalling."

Over 30 infants across the country have suffocated so far this year. The polyethylene plastic, through which air cannot pass, is drawn by a child's breathing against the nose and mouth, sealing them off.

**Human Rights  
Council Meets**

Ashland — The Human Rights council met Thursday evening at the Trinity Parish hall for their last study meeting until fall.

Francis Kelly reported on the ninth Oregon forum on intergroup relations which he attended at Portland State college earlier in the month. The theme of the conference was "Our Concern for human right in Oregon."

Kelly stated that it was reported that a company had given employment for the first time to members of minority groups and had experienced no difficulty with their being accepted. Soon employers were asking for more of them because they were different personalities and had something to offer. The experiment was successful largely because the company had first established a program of education to prepare employers and co-workers for the advent of people representing the minorities.

Fred Neal, chairman of the Ashland council, stressed that the primary function of the group is education.

A round table discussion was held on why individuals react to prejudice the way they do.

The board of directors will continue to meet through the summer.

**Residents Reminded  
To Cut Weeds-Grass**

Jacksonville—E. O. Graham, mayor, reminds residents that a city ordinance makes owners responsible for the mowing of grass and weed removal from vacant lots in the town.

It was stressed that the vacant lots should be tended to while the weeds and grass are still green. Once weeds have died they cause a fire hazard.

Members of the city council remind residents that the city is conducting a general clean up of the entire area.
