Salem Man Found Dead Near Stream

Hoskins, Ore.—(UPI)—A Salem fisherman was found dead near the Luckiamute river in southwest Polk county early today. Lowell Weese, 29, was believed to have died of a heart attack.

Mrs. James Chapman, operator of Fishermen's Camp near here, said Weese went fishing about 11 a.m. Tuesday. His father, Clarence E. Weese, assisted by state police, found the body about 4 a.m. today. The Polk county coroner's office said Weese apparently had a history of a heart condition.

Wall Collapses At Texas School; Girl, 13, Killed

Houston, Tex.—(UPI)—A heavy brick wall at McReynolds Junior High school crashed to the ground today just as students were entering for classes, killing a 13-year-old girl.

Principal Charles E. Poe said the 10-foot long, seven-foot high wall toppled suddenly as students were preparing to enter the building. Gloria Rivera, 13, was pinned under the wall and killed instantly.

Father Couldn't Move
Her father, Joe Rivera Sr., was standing 20 feet away and watched as the wall crashed down on his daughter. Witnesses said Rivera was so paralyzed with fear that he couldn't move to help the girl.

Rivera had just driven his daughter to the school and let her out in the driveway.

Poe said he had "no idea" what caused the wall to collapse. It was reported that students often played on it.

Witnesses said Gloria was talking to another student, Jean Schubert, 14, at the back of the modern, two-year-old school. The Schubert girl said she knew "something was wrong" with the wall and ran to safety.

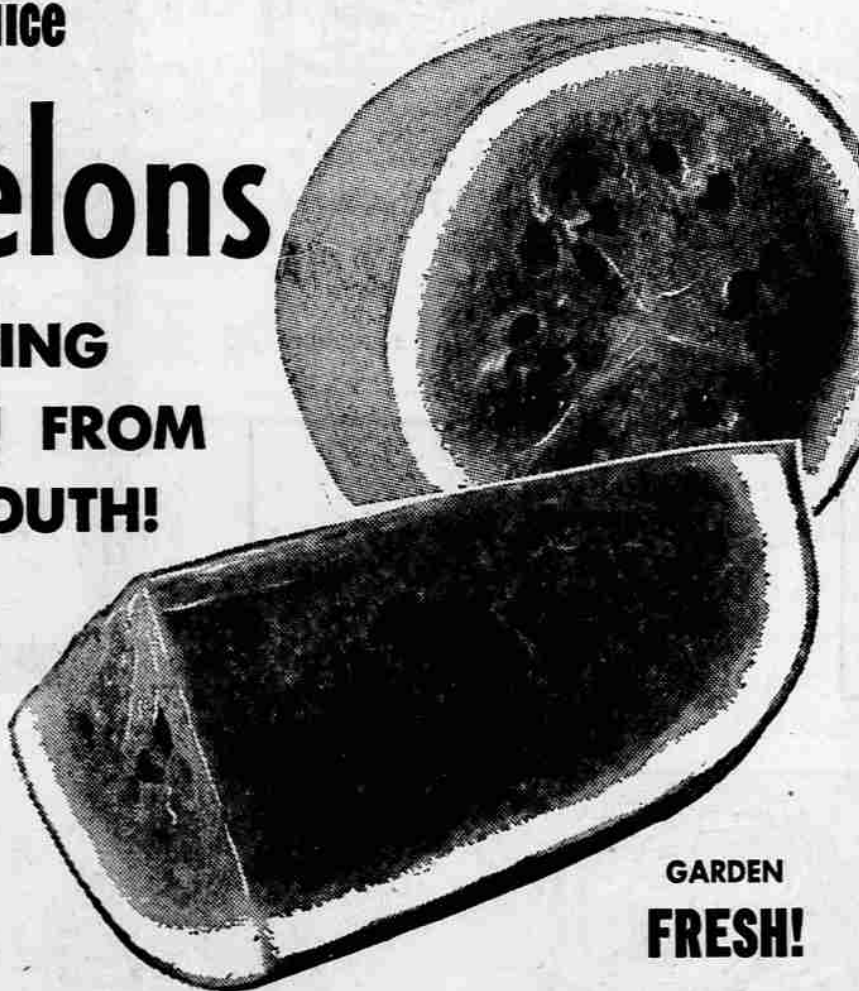
