

### Fourth Dies From Collision

Roseburg — (UP) — A car-pick-up truck collision May 22 just north of Winston on Highway 42 claimed a fourth victim Friday night. John David Terry, 26, Roseburg, died in community hospital here of injuries suffered in the crash.

Three others were killed outright. They were Everett K. Ward, 54, Roseburg; his wife, Gwendolyn Caroline Ward, 47, and William George Redenius, 63, also of Roseburg.

Terry was driver of the automobile, state police said. Redenius was his passenger and the Wards were in the pickup.

**SANDRA S.** — I am too busy for Aunt Carol.  
**JOHN S.** — We mustn't hurt her.

**SANDRA S.** — I am having a terrible problem with a very nice maiden lady in her 50s, who happens to be my husband's aunt.

Aunt Carol lives alone not very far from us. She is a typist and works at home all day. Of course, it is boring and lonely for her so she thinks nothing of calling me up or "dropping in" a few times a day.

I have three small children and a busy household to run. Aunt Carol sometimes gives me a hand with things, but usually she just wastes my time with gossip. I have hinted to her as nicely and tactful as I could that I am really too busy for these visits, but she doesn't pay attention and sometimes I think she is really hostile to me and wants to make trouble. My husband does nothing.

**JOHN S.** — What am I supposed to do about it? I can't go tell my aunt not to bother my wife. I told Sandra that she can say anything she likes, but she must not hurt Aunt Carol's feelings.

This aunt has always been a good friend to me and my folks. She helped see me through college and before my father died he told me to always look out for her because there is really nobody else in the family she can depend upon.

I always remind Sandra she certainly likes to have Aunt Carol "drop in" when she comes to babysit for us. After all, you can't always take and never give. It is hard for Aunt Carol being the way she is with no close friends. You can really go crazy with just the four walls to talk to.

**THE COUNCIL:** The person who has the biggest problem in this case is Aunt Carol and we don't believe that Sandra is helping things much by being too timid to speak up. John isn't helping either when he advises Sandra to say "anything" but not hurt Aunt Carol's feelings.

The fact is that some things must hurt, and one of them is the knowledge that we need someone who doesn't particularly need or want us. There are harsh ways and kind ways of telling off a person who has become somewhat of a pest, but even the kind way will hurt. It can only be hoped that the injured party will benefit by the pain, will suddenly come to an understanding that will bring about an inner change.

A maiden lady in her 50s who works at home all day and has no close friends is in an extremely bad fix and those who allow her to impose herself upon them are not doing her a good turn. There are hundreds of ways in which this woman can expand her life, but she must wake up and realize it herself. If she insists upon taking Sandra's words in the wrong spirit, she will just wrap herself in anger and self-pity and look for somebody else to use in the same way.

Sandra's idea that Aunt Carol is "really hostile" and wants "to make trouble" is probably false and based on irrational fear of an older woman who might represent her mother. Sandra may help herself in getting rid of this fear if she is aboveboard in a kindly way with Aunt Carol. She might even be helpful by suggesting that an accomplished typist like Aunt Carol would do well to get a job outside her home. It would probably bring her more money as well as social contacts.
