

Russia Said Near Manned Flight Test

Washington - (AP) - Both Russia and the United States are working on manned space vehicles.

The Soviet Union is rumored to be approaching the flight-test stage with a vehicle capable of placing a human crew in orbit around the earth. The satellite is supposed to be designed to return to earth safely.

On June 16, the U. S. Air Force awarded a contract to three major aviation firms - Bell, Martin and Boeing - to develop a "Dyna-Soar" vehicle large enough to carry one or two men. It would be placed in orbit by rockets, and would be capable of gliding back to earth. Target date for a flying model is 1963.

Burning Sensations in the Mouth and Tongue

Hundreds of elderly women write wanting to know why they have a burning in their tongue, or in their mouth. They say they have been to a dozen doctors who couldn't see anything, wrong, but gave them innumerable "shots" of vitamin B, without helping them any. Sometimes the patient can remember that the burning followed a curious spell in which she was so dizzy that she nearly blacked out, and some people have told me that the burning followed a definite stroke.

My impression then is that in these cases the disease is not in the tongue, but up in the brain. It appears to be due to the destruction of a tiny area in the brain by a little stroke which produced, perhaps a woody spell. I know of no treatment worth carrying out. In some cases the burning eventually goes away.

Page's Disease of the Bones

I get a number of questions as to Page's disease of the bone. Usually the patient doesn't say if it is producing any symptoms, or if it is producing symptoms, how severe and trying they are. Often Page's disease is discovered
