

# Oregon Protected If the Governor Becomes Disabled

Salem — There is no chance that Oregon could have the same situation as Louisiana whose governor, Earl Long, was flown to a psychiatric clinic in Galveston, Tex., for treatment.

The 1959 Legislature passed a bill suggested by Gov. Mark Hatfield that calls for a committee to determine in secret whether the governor is physically or mentally unable to perform duties of his office. The committee would be composed of the chief justice of the State Supreme Court, the superintendent of the state mental hospital in Salem and the dean of the University of Oregon medical school.

Their vote must be unanimous.

Many states are faced with the problem of moving their governor to another state so that the first in line of succession may legally take over.

This is because they have laws requiring the governor to be out of the state before his second in command can assume office.

During debate on the Oregon bill which corrects this situation, the Governor's staff testified that if Hatfield became incapacitated he would have to be removed to a Vancouver, Wash., hospital before Senate President Walter Pearson could legally take over the reins of state government. Hatfield suggested corrective legislation in his inaugural address.
