

Growers Threaten Berry Harvest

Woodburn—UPI—About 300 Willamette valley strawberry growers agreed Saturday night that if processors have not offered 14 cents a pound by Wednesday, the harvest will cease until the demands are met.

George Landrith, Clear Lake, representing the growers, said growers from as far south as Albany and north to Hillsboro attended the meeting at Woodburn Army. A 14 to 14½ cent market in California is the reason for

the increase request, he said. Most processors in Oregon at present are offering 13 cents per pound for the strawberries.

Landrith said the growers would meet again here on Wednesday.
