Farm Prices See Up, Down Cycle

Corvallis - Oregon farm prices were a mixture of ups and downs in May but averaged 1 per cent above May 1958, reports Mrs. Elvera Horrell, Oregon State college extension agricultural economist. In contrast to the Oregon trend, national farm prices are still 4 per cent below a year ago.

Prices in Oregon for poultry and dairy products continued to slip. Hogs, calves, and hay prices were also lower. On the upturn, however, were prices for potatoes, wheat, corn, beef cattle, lambs, and wool, the economist noted.

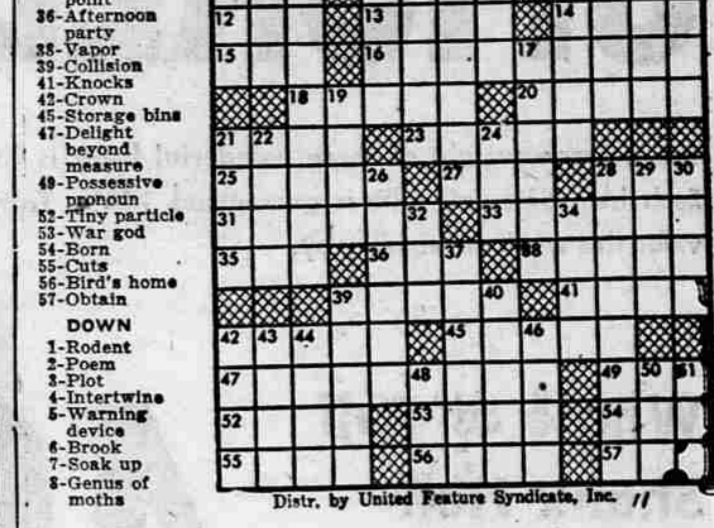
