

NOTICE OF 1959-60 BUDGET MEETING

In accordance with the provisions of the Local Budget Law (294.305 to 294.415), notice is hereby given that the Budget Committee of the City of Central Point, Oregon, in compliance with said law, prepared and adopted on May 28, 1959, the Budget estimates for the City of Central Point, Oregon, for the ensuing fiscal year July 1, 1959 to June 30, 1960, as set forth in the accompanying schedules I, II, III, IV. Former Phoenix Boy Critical With Polio

Danny York, 4-year-old son of the Rev. and Mrs. Leonard York, formerly of Phoenix, and Church of the Nazarene Missionaries in British Honduras, is reported in critical condition in a Miami, Fla., hospital with polio.

The Yorks, members of First Church of the Nazarene, Medford, spent a year in the valley leaving here June, 1957, for Corazal, British Honduras. They had previously spent four years here.

Danny, one of four sons, became ill May 26, but it was first thought he had malaria. When he showed signs of paralysis he was flown 80 miles to Belize where an iron lung was available at the British hospital.

Returned to U.S.

When the boy's condition worsened the American consul there made arrangements for him to be returned to the United States. The Key West Navy Base was contacted since they had a portable iron lung. Homestead Strategic Air Command base had a doctor and the Navy furnished a hospital corpsman. The 2-engine amphibious plane and crew of four were supplied by the Coast Guard.

In Belize, it was necessary to take the lung six miles from the airport to the hospital, then return to the plane. When the family arrived in Miami June 2, Danny was taken to the Variety Children's hospital.

Mrs. York is the former Miriam Cummons, daughter of C. L. Cummons, 1566 Pacific rd.

Local relatives reported that the Yorks have written President Eisenhower thanking him for the Armed Services part in getting Danny from British Honduras to the United States.

Prior to entering the missionary field, the Yorks established the First Church of the Nazarene in Yreka.

Zone Change Denied By City Planners

A requested zone change for all but two properties along the south side of East Jackson st. between Genesee and Stark sts., was denied last night by the Medford Planning commission.

The petitioners asked a change to limited commercial zoning. Cliff Ouellette, Medford attorney who represented them, stated the area was already in effect a commercial zone.

But commission members pointed out that granting the change would be against good planning policy. One noted that a change to limited commercial zoning had already been granted to Rogue Valley State bank for the northeast corner of Genesee and East Jackson sts., and explained that at approving commercial zoning on both sides of a street was considered and poor.

Maintaining Zoning

Ouellette commented that maintaining residential zoning for his clients "isn't a fair burden to place on homeowners living in a commercial zone but limited to residential use."

The apparent effect of the commission's action was to draw the line for further commercial zoning along East Jackson, for the time being at least, at the bank's property just east of Genesee. There is commercial zoning further east, however.

The planners deferred a public hearing on another zone change request for a
