Veneral Disease Is Still Dangerous
In the AMA News I was distressed to see that the rates for gonorrhoea and syphilis have been going up alarmingly. Perhaps youngsters now think that with penicillin a venereal disease is no longer dangerous. All young men should remember that syphilis still can ruin a life, and that the principal source of infection is the "pick-up" girl. Penicillin will work well in most cases of syphilis, but there is a small percentage in which, after strenuous treatment, the blood tests will remain positive, suggesting that the disease has not been entirely wiped out. In the case of gonorrhoea, there is a tendency for a type of germ to develop which is resistant to penicillin.

Paternity Suits
Recently, Dr. Leon N. Sussman and attorney Sidney B. Schatkin, of New York, told the American Academy of Forensic Sciences that, if only because of a great increase in the number of paternity suits, the time has come when courts must make up their minds whether or not they are going to trust the blood tests which, in many cases, will show that a man could not possibly be the father of a certain child. Dr. Sussman and Schatkin believe that 32 per cent of the men named as defendants in paternity suits are falsely accused, but 18 per cent of them give in, rather than go to the trouble of contesting the suit. Only some 10 per cent of the accused men fight the charge in the courts.

According to the authors, the blood tests provide the strongest possible defense, but in only 13 states are these tests accepted as decisive. So far as scientists can see, the tests ought to be used in all such cases. They don't show that a certain man is the father of the child, but if the blood groupings of the mother and the supposed father are known, in half of the cases it can be said definitely that the man could not possibly have been the father. It would seem that if scientists now are perfectly sure of this, judges ought to be, also. It should be obvious that a man who does not possess in his body certain characteristics cannot pass them on to his child. We all have sense enough to know that if a very blonde Scandinavian woman were to have a black-haired and black-eyed child, she could hardly accuse a very blond man of being the father. The principle is the same when a scientist uses the blood tests.
