

# Man Released After Serving 23 Years

Portland—(UPI)—Geither Horn, a transient who has served 23 years of a life term in the Washington state prison for murder, was ordered released Monday by Federal Judge Gus J. Solomon here.

Horn made application for a writ of habeas corpus and Judge Solomon heard the petition June 17 at Pasco, Wash. The judge ruled Monday that the prisoner had been deprived of due process of law under the 14th amendment of the Constitution.

Horn was tried and convicted of the murder in November, 1935, of another transient, never identified, near Pasco. He charged in his petition for a writ that his confession to the crime had been obtained by coercion and that the state had not furnished him with an attorney.

# The Medical Roundup

## Undulant Fever, or Brucellosis

Many people write to say that because they have a little fever occasionally, especially when they are nervous or upset over something or when they blow their top, their doctor suspects they have undulant fever, or brucellosis. They admit that when they went to a big place like a university clinic, the doctors said that the laboratory tests showed no sign of the disease. During my many years at the Mayo Clinic, when I was seeing many patients a day, I saw each year a group of persons supposed to have brucellosis. But, in practically every case, the expert bacteriologists to whom I referred the patient, could find no indications of the disease. The blood did not contain any excess of the so-called agglutinins that should form in the presence of a chronic bacterial disease.

Actually, most of the people in the United States who can be proved to have brucellosis, got it from cattle or swine. Nearly all of them are either farmers, cattle-raisers, veterinarians or workers in slaughter-houses. To show what can happen: I remember a young farmer who, when his cow calved and did not pass the afterbirth, reached in and pulled it out. Unfortunately, he had a cut on his finger; the cow had a diseased udder due to brucellosis and for two months the man had undulant fever. Because brucellosis is caught from animals, whenever I find a woman patient supposed to have the disease and I learn that she hardly knows what a cow or pig looks like, and has always drunk pasteurized milk, I tell her that I don't know who she could have gotten undulant fever. Then I send her to the laboratory and back comes a report that she shows no sign of it. In such cases, the more I talk with the woman the more impressed I am with the fact that she is just a bunch of nerves. In most cases any fever, she never had any fever. She loved the doctor who told her she had brucellosis because she hated the diagnosis of nervousness given her by all the other doctors in town.

## Harney REA Loan Receives Approval

Washington—(UPI)—Electric power for a large section of south Central Oregon was closer today with approval of a \$5,100,000 loan by Rural Electrification Administration to Haney Electric Cooperative of Burns.

As a result of REA action, Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore.) said he would ask the Senate appropriations committee to restore \$1,055,000 cut from the Bonneville power administration budget by the House for transmission lines between Burns and Redmond.

The House committee had eliminated this item because REA had not completed clearance of the Harney loan extending its distribution system to 155 new customers in Harney and Malheur counties and to 373 new customers in Northern Nevada.

## Article on Fever

I recently read an article on the type of illness suffered by those many laboratory workers who have gotten undulant fever while working with Brucella (the bacteria) in test tubes. Most of them were over their fever within a month or six weeks. Hence it is that most physicians when they see a highly neurotic woman who says she once got undulant fever, and is still supposed to have it several years later, suspect that she never had it, and what she had all along was only a neurosis.

This is a bit rough on the poor woman; I hate to take away from her her pet disease, but I think we have to do it.

I remember well a very unhappy and frail young wife, who, while trying to support herself and her husband while he was a student in college, cracked under the strain and had to take to her bed. The first doctors who saw her, diagnosed overwork, and with this, her mother-in-law, who had strongly disapproved of her marrying her son, made some nasty cracks. Then a doctor diagnoses brucellosis, and the young woman was delighted. But when the doctor couldn't cure the brucellosis, he sent the patient to me. When I told her that I

couldn't find a single sign of brucellosis, the girl went into hysterics and cried uncontrolably. As she admitted, she just had to have that diagnosis if she was to keep her mother-in-law from saying, "I told you so; that girl is too sickly for any use." Fortunately, I found a well-to-do uncle who agreed to help the student and his wife through college, and with this, my patient dried her eyes and took hope again. This poor young woman really had what I often call the disease that is due to being caught in a trap. For instance, I have known a number of young women who went to pieces nervously when they could not marry without deserting a widowed mother who was struggling to raise and educate several children.
