Tire Makers See End of Spare In Near Future

Atlantic City, N.J.—(Science Service)—When grandfather cranked up the "Model T" to go for a Sunday afternoon drive, he packed three spare tires—and often used them all. By 1930, two spares were still the rule. Now, representatives of three leading tire manufacturers report that with new improvements the days of the spare tire may soon be over.

The improvements being considered by all three companies are based on the idea of a tire within the tire. In effect, the tires would have built-in spares.

In addition to the obvious advantage of increased trunk space, the company spokesmen pointed out that elimination of the spare would decrease car weight and allow greater freedom of styling.

The dual compartment tire, being developed by the B. F. Goodrich Tire Company and the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, consists of two chambers, one inside the other. Each of these compartments is inflated through a separate valve. In case of a blowout, the inner tire would serve as a crutch to get the car to a service station. Tests conducted by Goodyear on taxicabs revealed that both the outer and the inner tires were punctured in only per six per cent of the blowouts.

The reserve chamber tire, under development by United States Rubber Company, has a deflated inner tube within the regular tire. If the outer tire is punctured, the "safety diaphragm" can be inflated with a seven and one-half-inch-long cartridge of compressed gas. This allows the motorist to continue for "many miles" before repairing his tire.

General acceptance has received considerable attention in eliminating the spare: "Every possible assist may be given the spare-elimination proposition if it is to overcome the psychological resistance present in the general public," said the spokesman for Goodrich.

Valuable Stamp Collection Stolen

Weston, Mass.—(UP)—Burglars, described by police as "real professionals" in judging the value of stamps, were sought today for stealing part of the Cardinal Spellman collection from Regis college.

Preliminary estimates of the loss ranged between \$25,000 and \$50,000 but officials said the amount could be higher.
