Ex-Seattle Cage Coach Minneapolis Laker Mentor

Minneapolis — (UPI) — John Castellani, 32, who never played any basketball himself but went on to be assistant coach at Notre Dame and head coach at Seattle, Saturday night was named coach of the Minneapolis Lakers in the National Basketball association.

Neither salary nor length of contract were disclosed.

Castellani thus replaced Johnny Kundla, who last season led the Lakers to second place in the western division and an upset playoff win over the first place St. Louis Hawks, then resigned to take over the basketball helm at the University of Minnesota.

"It's something like slipping into Milwaukee Braves' manager Fred Haney's job," Castellani said. "You're coming into a team that went to the finals of the NBA championship playoffs."

The Lakers eventually lost the finals to the Boston Celtics, eastern division champions.

It earlier had been thought that either Laker captain Vern Mikkelsen or former star Jim Pollard would succeed Kundla.

Castellani, who played only high school basketball, graduated from Notre Dame in 1950, then went to Notre
