**Russia Tests Live Polio Vaccine on 4 Million Persons**

Washington—(Science Service)—More than 4,000,000 Russians have gulped down, in one form or another, a live virus that is capable of preventing paralytic polio. The live virus vaccine used in Russia is an offspring of the live polio virus developed by Dr. Albert Sabin of the University of Cincinnati. Results so far look good—persons who have received the virus have built up protective levels of antibodies against the crippling form of polio. Decision in Autumn

However, Russia faces her polio season now and through the summer, so that it will be autumn before Russian scientists know definitely how much protection this vaccine offers. Dr. M. K. Voroshilova, Institute for the Study of Poliomyelitis, Academy of Medical Sciences, Moscow, told Science Service.

Many of these Russians have already received the Salk vaccine which contains killed virus. Others have received either the one vaccine or the other. The country is so large that various sections receive different types of vaccine, the woman scientist said.

Dr. Herald Cox, identified with the Lederle Laboratories strain of live virus vaccine, reassured reporters that well controlled experiments with the live virus could be a useful measure even among persons who have received the Salk vaccine.

**Antibodies Level Goes Up** When a person receives the Salk vaccine, his body builds up a certain level of immunity to polio. Then, when he receives a dose of the live virus, the level of antibodies shoots even higher. To date, few such tests have been carried out in the United States because some scientists felt that the immunizing effect of the live virus would not be evident due to the mass inoculation of Salk vaccine.

One question would remain unanswered in the event of a polio epidemic in an area where persons had received both vaccines. It would be impossible to determine which vaccine prevented the polio from crippling the vaccinated.

**San Diego Ideal For Boating Fans**

San Diego, Calif.—(UPI)—Thousands of acres of protected water and a mild climate combine to make this southern California seaport city one of the nation's most ideal spots for boating enthusiasts.

There are more than 12,000 pleasure boats registered here and private ownership is increasing at the rate of 100 boats a week, making San Diego what one might call a "boat in every garage" city.

San Diego Harbor, dotted with hundreds of naval and commercial vessels, and Mission Bay, now being developed as the nation's outstanding aquatic park, provide facilities to handle everything from paddleboards to ocean-going yachts.

The center of boating activities in San Diego Bay, a boot-shaped harbor containing 25 miles of navigable waters, is Shelter Island, a man-made peninsula providing ample car and boat-trailer parking facilities as well as launching ramps. And it's free.

Shelter Island will be even more attractive this summer with completion of a new marina, complete with slips for 135 boats of all sizes up to 115 feet and every service needed by visiting yachtsmen from showers to restaurant.

**Air Conditioning Benefits Patients**

New Orleans—(UPI)—A study at Charity hospital here showed that most patients "were greatly benefited by air conditioning," which was "particularly important for the patient with heart disease."

Benjamin R. Ebersman, president of a firm (Mathes Co.) which manufactures air-conditioning equipment, said the study included 82 patients in an air-conditioned ward and 75 in a ward that wasn't. Ebersman said "air conditioning eliminated sweating, fostered a calm and quiet atmosphere, improved morale of both patients and attending personnel, removed allergens from the environment and increased the tolerance of enforced bed rest."

As for cardiac patients, Ebersman said the heart did not have to work as hard in an air-conditioned room as it did when the atmosphere was warm and humid.
