The Medical Roundup

A Psychopathic Delinquent

A number of people, nearly out of their mind with anxiety over a very wayward son, write wanting to know what can be done for a psychopathic delinquent. Often it is a young man, but it can be a young woman.

The person appears to have been born without any moral sense or any desire to earn a living and settle down with a wife to build a home and an honorable position in the community. He has absolutely no consideration for the rights of others, and he has no shame.

Lupus Erythematosus

People keep asking about lupus erythematosus. This is a disease which tends to flare up every so often. It affects not only the skin but many of the organs throughout the body, such as the heart, arteries, and kidneys. The patient should be under the care of a good physician. Sometimes, during the flare-up or "crisis," the patient can be tied over with cortisone-like drugs, or perhaps Atabrine.

An Albino

An unhappy mother writes to say that one of her children is an albino, with flaxen hair, and pink, colorless eyes. These people are usually squinting because the sunlight hurts them so. They probably all ought to wear dark glasses. The mother is much worried because people tell her that an albino is mentally retarded, but, as she says, her child certainly is not.

Behavior Described

There are two wonderful books about these people; one is "The Mask of Sanity," by Dr. Hervey Cleckley of Augusta, Georgia (Mosby). He describes in a masterly way the behavior of a number of these men and women. As he points out, the police may soon get tired of arresting a young delinquent, and sometimes then the judge will end up refusing to have anything more to do with the lad.

STUDY VOTING AGE

Nashville, Tenn. (UPI)—Lowering of the minimum voting age from 21 to 18 will be one of the major items of consideration at Tennessee's fifth constitutional convention that begins today. Ninety-nine delegates will attend the convention, the second since the present charter was adopted in 1870.

JAPAN'S ECONOMY RISES

Tokyo (UPI)—The Japanese government reported today that the nation's economy had recovered from the 1957-58 recession at an "unexpectedly swift pace." The report warned, however, that Japan "has lagged far behind the Western nations in liberalization of trade" and urged that corrective measures be taken immediately.

Washington—(UPI)—Opponents of Dominican Generalissimo Rafael Leonidas Trujillo charged Monday that he has started a purge of his close associates.

These sources, who asked that their names not be used, claimed a new "reign of terror" is under way as a result of the strong man's fears that he may be overthrown.

As those who opposed Trujillo talked of a purge, further information was sought on the mysterious death of Ramon Marrero Arista, the Dominican Republic's minister of labor and Trujillo's press officer.
