Survival in Cases of Lung Cancer

In a recent article, Drs. Katharine R. Boucot, Utake Horie and Martin J. Sokoloff reported on the study of 250 consecutive cases of cancer originating in the bronchi, or air tubes leading into the lungs. Usually, a cancer patient is supposed to be cured if he has survived for five years after the operation. In this series, 17 per cent of the patients operated on were alive after five years. The outlook was better than average for patients who had been operated on before they got symptoms, and it was better for those who had a so-called squamous cell cancer. The authors suggest that older persons go twice a year for an x-ray examination of the chest. This is the surest way of avoiding death from a cancer of the lung.
