Returns to Jacksonville

**Vance Colvig
To Attend Gold
Rush Jubilee**

Jacksonville - Vance "Pinto" Colvig, Hollywood, will return to his home town this week end to take part in the Jacksonville Gold Rush Jubilee as the official host.

Colvig, who was born in Jacksonville in 1892, attended schools in Jacksonville and Medford and later Oregon State college before joining the L. G. Barnes circus.

He worked for a San Francisco newspaper, where he met Walt Disney, and with his versatile voice assisted the producer in creating Pluto the Pup and later provided the voices of Grumpy and Sleepy in Disney's "Snow White."

He has since been the voice of many other characters on screen and radio and has made many tours throughout the country.

The "village clown," as he describes himself, is listed in Who's Who as one of the pioneers in animated cartoons. He performs for Capital Records as Bozo the Clown.

Sixty years ago he sang in Jacksonville in the "Old Opry House" in the U. S. Hotel. He is working on a book-length manuscript "Clowns is People," mostly a story of his "kidhood days in Jacksonville."

**African Tries to
Sell Friend to FD**

Kampala, Uganda - (UPI) - A widespread belief among East African tribesmen that fire brigades traffic in human flesh brought Nusula Bua into court here - accused of trying to sell his friend to the fire department.

He was alleged to have called at the fire station one night with his friend Alibino Ongom, with an offer to sell Ongom to Fire Chief W. D. Flint for 75 pounds (\$120).

Bua denied the charge, claiming he was looking for a job and counter-charged that if he refused to sell his friend, both of them would be eaten.

Bua was remanded to a higher court. The belief that the fire department is a cannibal sect originated in East Africa about 20 years ago, when the bright red fire engines were first introduced.

Their appearance coincided with a sales drive by a meat canning firm. To attract African custom, the firm used a bright red wrapper with the picture of a smiling African head on it.
