Spectator Records Testimony at 'Sex' Survey Hearing

Los Angeles - (UPI) - A man who disrupted the "Little Kinsey" sex survey hearing of a high school teacher by recording testimony faced possible Superior Court contempt charges today.

Francis Harmon, 41, electrical engineer with the city Department of Water and Power, caused the hearing to be recessed temporarily Wednesday when another spectator spotted him operating a tape recorder. A 17-year-old high school student testifying at the time refused to continue unless Harmon stopped recording.

The girl was a student of math and science teacher Cecil M. Cook, 38, facing loss of his teaching certificate for conducting a sex survey among his physiology classes comprised of boys and girls 15 to 17 years old.

The hearings later were recessed until Monday. They began last Monday. Hearing officer Alfred J. McGuire of the California Department of Professional and Vocational Standards, which is conducting the hearing, ordered Harmon out of the room.

He also ordered Harmon to erase the tape, which the man refused to do. McGuire later allowed Harmon to return to

the hearings on the condition he did not use the recorder. He said he would seek a contempt citation against Harmon.

The engineer explained his interest in recording the proceedings was "that of a taxpayer." He also said he was a member of a group called Equal Rights which is dedicated to making certain court and hearing transcripts are correct. He said the group began inaccuracies in divorce court transcripts, but admitted the recordings had nothing to do with the group.

Pupils Defend Teacher
Cook was defended at the hearings Wednesday by eight students, six of them girls, who said his questions about intimate sex relationships were "dignified and scientific."

Judy Kessler, 17, said she was unaware of any objection to Cook's sex survey in her class last January. He was suspended in February after several students complained.

Another 17-year-old explained that she thought Cook's delving into sex problems was good.

"I feel the course was very instructive because on my wedding night I would like to have the answers to some of the questions asked."

Woman Attacked Fourth Time by Same Rapist

Canoga Park, Calif. - (UPI) - A woman who four years ago branded a handsome man on the face with an electric iron when he tried to rape her was attacked for the fourth time Wednesday by the same vengeful rapist.

Mrs. Patricia Fay Smith, 30, mother of three children, was cut on the legs, thighs, arms and chest by the rapist who has sworn revenge on her for disfiguring him. The cuts all were minor.

Mrs. Smith said her family has had to move two times since July 16, 1955, when she burned an ugly three-inch long scar on the left side of her attacker's face. She said she was ironing clothing in her kitchen when he first attacked her.

The attractive red-haired mother said the rapist forced his way into her home Wednesday, held her prisoner in the bathroom and slashed her with a pocket knife before the return home of her eldest son scared him off.

Not Finished Yet
"I'm not finished with you yet," the man warned her before leaving, she told police. "I'll be seeing you again. You'll know what it feels like to go through life with your face scarred."

Mrs. Smith said the rapist was strikingly handsome.

Alaska Supreme Court Is Named

Anchorage, Alaska - (UPI) - Buell A. Besbett, 49, Anchorage attorney, Wednesday was named chief justice of the Alaska Supreme Court.

The appointment was announced by Gov. William A. Egan, who also named U.S. District Judge Walter Hodge, Nome, and John Dimond, a Juneau attorney, as associate justices of the Supreme Court.

Alaska has been without a court system since it became the 49th state of the union. The date the Alaska court will take jurisdiction is still undecided as members will be given time to conclude their personal affairs before taking office.

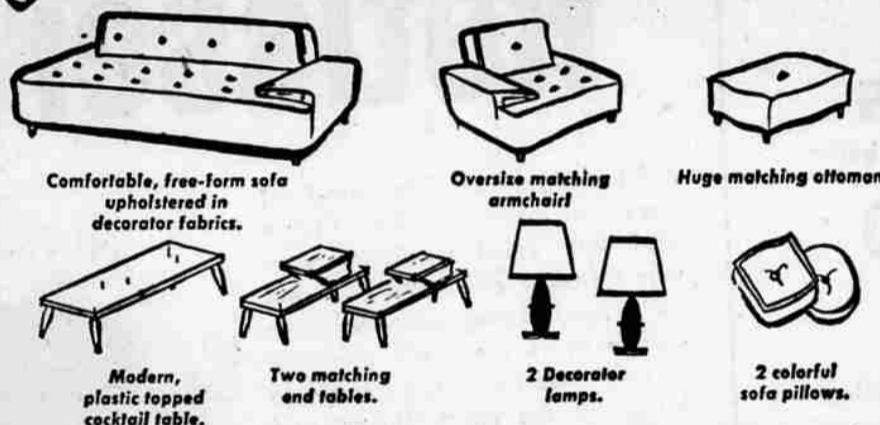
