Medford owners of outdoor swimming pools, fish ponds and certain other artificial bodies of water are faced with a new city ordinance requiring fences or covers for them. The ordinance, passed by the city council July 16, sets forth as public policy that without proper precautions pools and ponds "constitute a severe hazard to the safety of the inhabitants of the City of Medford, particularly children."

Excludes Public Pools

Latching Device

All gates or doors, except the door of a building supplementing the fence or wall, must have a self-closing, self-latching device to keep it shut when not in actual use.

Enforcement of the Ordinance

Violators are subject to fines up to \$100 or 30 days in jail or both, with each day the violation continues to exist considered a separate offense.

Receive Dividend
