

Tillamook Blast Idles Veneer Plant

Tillamook - (UPI) - The Tillamook Veneer company plant here remained closed today after Saturday's explosion of a boiler room tank and a spokesman said it would be 10 days to two weeks before operations could be resumed.

Joe Stanek, 50, an employee who was injured when the tank blew up and who was taken to Tillamook General hospital, was released Sunday night.

Some 240 men are idled. The blast, cause of which has not been determined, leveled a six-inch cement wall 10 feet from the tank.

Pease AFB, N.H. - (UPI) - A B52 Stratofortress crashed 15 miles west of here in southeastern New Hampshire today but all nine men on board parachuted to safety.

The \$8 million aircraft from Westover Air Force Base at Chicopee, Mass., crashed in the Brentwood-Kingston area.

The base information officer said the men walked to a Candia, N.H., gasoline filling station to await transportation back to the base. First reports said none was injured.

The first report of the accident was from a construction worker who witnessed the crash and telephoned Pease Air Force Base.

He said he saw the big plane falling and a number of parachutes in the sky above it.
