House Gets Bill To Create YCC

Washington — (UPI) — A Senate bill to set up a federal Youth Conservation Corps went to the House today.

The measure, designed to save both the nation's teenagers and natural resources from ruin, was passed by a 47-45 Senate vote Thursday despite Republican ridicule of the proposal.

The bill would establish a program similar to the New Deal's Civilian Conservation Corps. In the first year, 50,000 young men, aged 16 to 21, would be enrolled in the corps. Eventually, it would grow to 150,000. Service would be from six months to two years. The pay would be \$60 a month, plus room, board and transportation.

Southerners Opposed — Republican Sens. Alexander Wiley (Wis.) and Milton Young (N.D.) joined 45 Democrats voting for the bill. Thirty Republicans and 15 Democrats, mostly southerners, opposed it.

Sponsors of the measure said the corps would remove potential juvenile delinquents from the "asphalt jungles" of the big cities and speed up federal timber, soil and other resources conservation.

GOP critics complained that the program would soon cost \$375 million a year.

Bend Man's Body Found in River

Tillamook — (UPI) — The body of George Poetschat, 48, Bend, was recovered Thursday from the Nastucca river near Pacific City.

Tillamook county sheriff's deputies here said Poetschat was apparently driving from Nestucca to Hanneman's resort, about 20 miles south of here, when his car plunged into the river.

Skindivers of the sheriff's rescue squad found the body lodged between two rocks about 40 feet from the car. A road crew discovered the submerged auto.

Police said Poetschat was apparently in the area on a fishing trip.

Surviving him is his widow, Ruth.

'CHOPPER' PILOT KILLED

New York — (UPI) — A 30-year-old Army warrant officer was killed Thursday when his helicopter crashed during a landing approach on Governors Island in New York Bay. He was identified as Lester B. Bunderick, Henderson, Tex., stationed with the air section of the 52nd Anti-Aircraft Brigade at Miller Field, Staten Island.

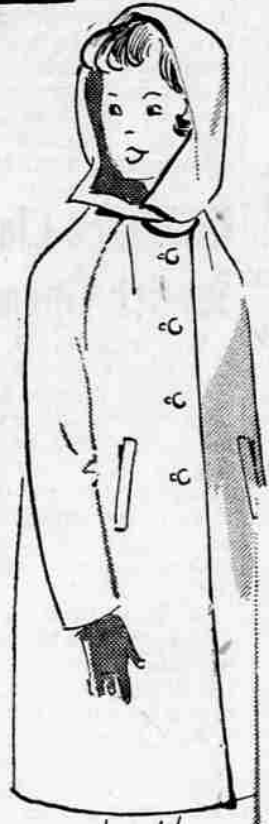
