

### Case Histories Of Ocean Storms Will Be Studied

Corvallis—Case histories of ocean storms that sweep across Oregon will be charted by Oregon State college meteorologists with a \$280,000 portable weather radar system provided by the Army signal corps.

Dr. Fred W. Decker, associate professor of physics who directs OSC's weather research, was informed of the equipment allocation.

The high-powered system, capable of "seeing rain and snow" within 250 miles or more, is housed in two vans. This is the latest modern equipment used for weather radar work by the Army and Air Force.

Now housed at Mercury, Nev., where it tracked storms for atomic tests, the equipment will arrive at OSC about Sept. 15. Scientists know the equipment as CPS-9.

The equipment will be taken to Mary's Peak, highest mountain in the Coast Range, and other summits to observe the storms as they move over the coastal region, Willamette valley and into and across the Cascades.

In addition, a \$33,000 grant has been received from the Army signal corps for the research. In the past five years since meteorology research was started by OSC, grants totaling \$152,000 have been received.

**Possibilities Studied**  
Possibilities and techniques for forecasting path of the storm, storm intensity, time of precipitation, and duration of the storm will be studied. Great advances in weather observations and forecasts have come with radar, Dr. Decker noted. Radar is now used to map rainfall, detect hail and tornadoes, track severe storms, plot storm growth and locate the freezing level.

Working with Dr. Decker on the project will be Herbert Kershaw Jr., Wilfred G. Jensen and Wendell M. Cook, who will be on leave from the weather bureau at Salem to study at OSC.

### Californians Return From Mexico Trip

### Freight Train Hits Log Truck, Trailer

Aumsville, Ore. — (AP) — A Southern Pacific freight train struck a logging truck and trailer just east of here Wednesday, but no one was injured.

Driver of the truck was Floyd Dickson, Canby, and the train engineer was John Davis, Salem, state police reported.

Dickson said he saw the train too late to stop and that the impact sent logs flying over a wide area.

The lead locomotive of the train had its front end pushed in and the truck and trailer was knocked over.

SP officials said the train was headed for a plywood mill.

### Magnuson Praises Conservation Step

Washington—(UPI)—Sen. Warren G. Magnuson (D-Wash.), Wednesday praised Senate action which approved a measure designed to determine the best means of improving conservation of game fish in federal reservoirs.

The bill would direct the secretary of interior to establish a research program aimed at finding the best method of conserving reservoir fish.

Magnuson said federal agencies have neglected fishing yields in most reservoirs with the result that "some have become barren of food and game fish as predators and scrap fish have multiplied."
