

Woman Who Swallowed Live Mouse Disturbed By So Much Commotion

Denver - (UP) - A Denver woman who swallowed a live mouse last Friday says she never would have gone to the hospital if she had known it would have caused so much commotion.

Mrs. Florence Hill said she has been deluged with telephone calls and stacks of mail from all over the country, most of it wanting to know if the story were actually true.

Might Be Different

"If I were a young person, it might be different," she said indignantly "but a woman 67 years old isn't going to be telling lies like this."

"I would have been a little more strategic if I had wanted

to stir up all the publicity I have been given."

The "publicity" started the day after her pet dog, Boots, awakened her from her sleep with his growling. She looked up and saw a two-inch mouse jumping around near her bed.

She said it was standing on top of her clock. She opened her mouth to scream and the mouse jumped in and wriggled its way down her throat.

The next day one of her friends persuaded her to go to Denver General Hospital.

Mrs. Hill said she stayed at the hospital for 12 hours. Doctors admitted they were amazed at her story but said they had no reason to doubt it. They kept her hospitalized

but when she suffered no ill effects they sent her home.

No More Mice

The next day she said her telephone started ringing. "I find the entire affair hideous and at the same time comical," the widow said, "but I never want to see another mouse again as long as I live."
