Salem - (UP) - State Republican Chairman Peter Gunnar said today he did not know whether Vice President Richard Nixon would be available for political meetings while in Oregon to dedicate The Dalles dam in October.

Nixon sent word Wednesday he would be on hand to dedicate the big dam on Oct. 10.

Nixon is one of at least three possible presidential candidates who plan to visit Oregon in the near future. Others include Democratic Senators John Kennedy and Hubert Humphrey and possibly Lyndon Johnson of Texas, who might stop in Oregon on a return trip from Alaska.
