New York—The bull market may be tired and old, but it isn't dead, says Prentice-Hall.

The firm notes that the bull market is becoming more and more vulnerable to sharp reactions, such as the 5 per cent drop experienced this month.

However, it adds that breaks of 10 per cent or more are normal before a bear market can be said to have arrived. The firm still expects the Dow-Jones industrial average to hit the 700-mark in 1960.

As the bull market grows

older," it cautions, "expect sharper reactions, increasing selectivity, and continuing rotation in the industry groups favored by investors."

Joseph E. Granville, analyst for E. F. Hutton & Co., says the refusal by Congress to raise the long-term ceiling rates on government bonds was "a very serious blunder."

He says the rise in short-term interest rates could turn all economic lines down and a monetary crisis could ensue.
