

Reserve Officers School Scheduled In Ashland Soon

Navy reserve officers school is scheduled to start at Ashland on Sept. 14. Naval and Coast Guard reserve officers are offered a choice of 40 subjects which give them a chance to earn credits for promotion and retirement.

Classes start in Salem and Eugene on the same date, and at Portland on Sept. 15.

More than 40 courses have been prepared by the Navy department and are being administered in Oregon by trained instructors, many of whom are professional educators. Any of the courses can be available with adequate student interest.

Become Eligible
Officers who take courses become eligible for two weeks active duty pay, although training duty is not required of students. The school year consists of two 20-week semesters with graduation in June, 1960.

The courses offered represent a comprehensive coverage of promotional requirements in the executive, operations and technical areas as set forth in the current promotion plan for Naval and Coast Guard reserve officers.

The school is now in its sixth year on a nation-wide basis. It represents the Navy's first venture into group education and training of at-home officers. It has grown since its inception in 1953 from three schools and 250 students to its 1959 strength of 101 schools, 69 branches and more than 12,000 students.

Museum Notes 9,566 Visitors

Jacksonville — A total of 9,566 persons visited the Jacksonville museum during August, Miss Mary Hanley, curator, said today. The total was 2,325 more than the number who visited the museum in August, 1958.

During the two-day Jacksonville Jubilee, 1,744 visitors registered at the museum, whose total attendance since it opened July 10, 1950, is now 353,831.

Visitors registered from 45 states, Washington, D. C., Canada, England, Scotland, France, Germany, Italy, South Africa, Turkey, Sweden, Afghanistan, Thailand, Japan, Brazil and Tasmania.

Groups touring the museum included the Rainbow Garden club, Grants Pass, a Camp White Domiciliary group, a delegation of travel editors, a visual aids class from Southern Oregon college, the Emerald Empire Builders, Eugene, the San Jose Vagabonds of the adult education center, San Jose college, and a Great Books discussion group from Portland.

Extradition of Motherwell Asked

Atlanta—UPI—California authorities were to call on Georgia Gov. Ernest Vandiver today to ask that Larry Lord Motherwell be extradited to Sierra County, Calif., to face murder charges.

"We don't have any plans other than to get Motherwell an dtake him back to California," Sheriff Wilbur D. Johnson of Sierra county said when he arrived here Wednesday night from Washington, D.C., the home of the 72-year-old widow Motherwell is charged with murdering.

Motherwell was arrested Aug. 25 by FBI agents at the Atlanta Airport. He was sought by federal agents on a charge of flight to avoid prosecution. He is held in \$50,000 bail.

His alleged victim, Mrs. Pearl Ida Putney, disappeared last summer after taking a motor trip with Motherwell through the South and West.
