## The Medical Roundup

### Late Bed-Wetting

Recently Dr. Bertil Hallgren, of Copenhagen reported a study of 248 bed-wetters, together with their families. He found that boys have more trouble with this disease than do girls. That the difficulty is based often on some congenital peculiarity is suggested by the fact that Dr. Hallgren found among the bed-wetters eight times as many instances of congenital pyloric stenosis (narrowing of the lower end of the stomach which causes severe vomiting in infants) than he found in the general population. He found, also, as I have found, that not infrequently there is great nervousness and sometimes even a few mental breakdowns among some of the relatives. Hallgren found that in the matter of behavior, 41 of the children were, to some extent, problem cases. He found that many of the children who wet the bed late had relatives who had suffered from the same difficulty, and 26 per cent of these had a behavior problem when they were young. Hallgren found among the bed-wetters a number of speech disorders, with emotional immaturity and general nervousness. The incidence of these troubles was greater than it is among the population. In some cases the mother was mentally disturbed, or the home was broken or unhappy. Often, when the mother of a bed-wetter is questioned about the child, she will say that he is a bit clumsy, and that he hasn't good control over his muscles. A Loud Heart Murmur

Quite a few anxious mothers write to say that their boy has been found to have a heart murmur due probably to congenital heart disease, and she wants to know if she should rush somewhere to have him operated on. As I have to keep saying in this column, I cannot answer her because I have no facts to help me. The first question that comes to my mind is, is the boy ill in any way? Can he play baseball? Can he do anything on the track team, or can he swim well? Or is he comfortable while walking along the street? If so, I would not be too worried about him. The child I would worry about is the one who is short of breath; who, when he was small, wanted to be picked up and carried, and who, when he exercised a bit, got blue lips.

In answer to a column I recently wrote on this subject, I got a delightful letter from a wide-awake man of 83, who is still so active and well that his doctor thinks he'll live until he is 100. This man says that in February, 1901, when he was a U. S. soldier in the Philippines, an army doctor who happened to examine him
