Coquille Agent Gets Service Award

"These reports," he said, "do not collect dust in our office. They provide the basis for planned traffic engineering, enforcement and educational programs."

"Each accident report received by our department," he said, "is pinpointed on a map so we can see where accident 'hot spots' are developing."

The next problem is to determine whether the situation could be remedied by engineering or enforcement or, in some cases, both. Safety experts then use the accumulated reports to guide them in developing a safety education program.

Accident reports must be filed within 24 hours, the police chief reminded.

When local agencies are through with the reports, they are forwarded to the department of motor vehicles in Salem where they are analyzed to help state officials plan needed statewide traffic safety activities and spot accident-prone drivers. They also become the basis for engineering improvements and enforcement in rural areas.

Strike Slated at Bay Area Papers

San Francisco—(UPI)—San Francisco's three major daily newspapers will be struck by the San Francisco—Oakland Newspaper Guild Sunday, the guild announced today.

It would be the first strike in the 21-year history of SFONG.

Picket lines will be set up outside the San Francisco News-Call Bulletin, Examiner, and Chronicle plants at 8 a.m.

Formal notice of the strike was given the newspapers in a letter to E. F. Bitler, manager of the San Francisco Newspaper Publisher's association, from Sam B. Eubanks, executive secretary of the guild.

Management's last offer was for raises of from \$2.50 to \$5.50 weekly this year and from \$2 to \$4 next year.

The guild asked raises of from \$4 to \$10 this year and from \$3 to \$7 next year.
