Noise, Light Help People To Relax

Bloomington, Ind.—(Science Service)—The old joke about the man who could not sleep because the quiet kept him awake has received scientific support. Research by Dr. R. C. Davis, Indiana University psychologist indicates that people relax better in a little noise and light than they do in a dark sound-proofed room. Subjects in the dark and quiet showed increased muscular and circulatory activity and decreased respiration. Dr. Davis reports in the Journal of Comparative and Physiological Psychology.

This pattern, Dr. Davis explains, is characteristic of anticipation. The subjects in the dark, he said, may have been less relaxed because they were "expecting something to happen."

Spots Before the Eyes

Many worrisome people are much concerned when they see floating spots before their eyes. If these spots are very small or stringy and of the type that drifts about when one looks at the sky, the person need not feel any concern. They are what the eye specialist calls floating opacities. Some are in the tears on the front of the eye and some are in the watery fluid that lies between the lens and the front window of the eye. Back of the lens there is a jelly-like substance which isn't always perfectly clear.

But spots in it are not likely to float. There may also be opacities in the lens of the eye, opacities such as can end up, producing a cataract. People past middle age will sometimes get a blind spot which will last for a few minutes and then go away. The spot may be red or brown, and the doctor will suspect that it was due to the plugging-up of a tiny artery back in the brain. Rarely, there is a blind spot which will appear in only one eye, due to injury to one of the tiny arteries, or perhaps to an inflammation of a spot in the retina, or sometimes to the detachment of part of the retina from the back of the eye. Nevada, Iowa (UPI)—A university honor student said Wednesday he got an "urge to kill" a mother and her adopted daughter while watching Nikita S. Khrushchev on television. Barry Neal McDaniel, 20, rated a brilliant mathematics and physics student at Iowa State university, was formally charged with the strangulation of Mrs. Monica Irene Larson, 25, and the suffocation of her 4-month-old adopted daughter, Kimberly Anne, Tuesday.

McDaniel told his lawyer, Frank Lounsbury, that he got the "urge to kill" as he watched the televised accounts of the arrival of Soviet Premier Khrushchev in Washington.
