## JOHNNY GUENTHER

One of the nation's fastest rising young stars, Johnny Guenther of Seattle, Washington, is a member of the American Machine and Foundry Company Bowling Promotion Staff.

Johnny holds the Pacific Northwest record for the highest series, an 809 rolled in 1954. He was Seattle's All-Star Champion in 1956-57 and was named that city's "Bowler of the Year" for the same season on the strength of his 198 average. For the 1957-58 campaign, Guenther compiled a sparkling 204 average and won Seattle's Recreation Doubles Title. In 1957, he tied for fourth place in the ABC singles and finished 10th in the 1957 Masters Tournament, putting together a 202 average for the 24 games he rolled.

Guenther captured the All-Army singles crown and placed second in the all-events before his discharge from the U.S. Army in July, 1958.



## FOY BELCHER

Foy Belcher, a member of the Bowling Promotion Staff of American Machine and Foundry Company, is one of the West Coast's finest bowling instructors and a leading California bowler, as well.

Foy was BPAA National Match Game Finalist in 1955, and in 1952 he placed fifth in the ABC Doubles competition.

In 1954, he won the Citrus Belt Lanes classic title with a score of 1517 for seven games. Also, in 1954, he was the winner of the Los Angeles Examiner classic scoring 2068 out of ten games.

A real asset to the greater Los Angeles All Stars, he has a top league series of 773, and a high league game of 299 to his credit.

Foy favors a four-step delivery and rolls a medium hook ball. A bowler for nine years, he holds a lifetime average of 200. His best league average took place in the Pasadena Classic circuit in 1953-1954 where he hit the 207 mark.

An eager participant in all sports, Foy presently sets up bachelor quarters in Glendale, Calif.
