In the last few years hundreds of people have written asking about hepatitis, or an inflammation of the liver. In the old days, when I was a medical student, I was taught mainly about one type of hepatitis — the epidemic one — in which a person gets jaundiced, usually for a few days. Perhaps he has a little fever, some loss of appetite, and a feeling of ill

After years of struggle to find some way of getting the virus out of plasma it looks now as if laboratory men have learned how to do it. What they do is to store the plasma in a warm place. Unfortunately, we have not yet found any satisfactory dietary or drug treatment for hepatitis. Usually, the patient has to wait and hope for the best.

Search for Bodies Continued in Italy

Barietta, Italy—UPI—Search crews worked around the clock today in the grim hunt for additional victims of the collapse of a five-story apartment house.

Thus far, the bodies of 55 men, women and children have been recovered from the 30-foot high pile of rubble and debris. No one was sure how many others were still buried but estimates ranged as high as 38.

Thirteen injured persons also were rescued in the first few hours after the building collapsed.

Florence—UPI—Glen 'Cattlet, 44, Reedsport, died Wednesday in a hospital here from injuries suffered in a woods accident on Smith river, about 28 miles northeast of Reedsport.
