## Complications From Tranquilizers Are Rare, Doctor Says

With increasing experience, it has been found that major complications from tranquilizing drugs are rare, Dr. Leo E. Hollister reported in a lecture this morning at the annual convention here of the Oregon State Medical Society.

In talks to delegates yesterday and today, Dr. Hollister, chief of medical services of the Veterans Administration hospital at Palo Alto, Calif., discussed the present status of tranquilizing drugs and the complications from their use.

Complications, he stated, are not the concern they were initially. They are certainly worth risking, he remarked, if the tranquilizer drugs are needed or indicated for proper treatment. Dr. Hollister emphasized that complications are unusual and that, for every patient who suffers one, thousands have been treated without difficulty.

Stressing non-psychiatric uses of tranquilizers in one of his talks, the VA man said

that, even if there were no psychiatric treatments with these drugs, they would still be useful. He pointed out that first emphasis on the drugs was for non-psychiatric purposes and that use as tranquilizers came about just incidentally.

Dr. Hollister elaborated on different members of the tranquilizer groups which have been effective in treating psychiatric patients. Interest in these drugs has put more of them on the market, he said, but the first put out are just about as good as those brought out later.

Reporting on the phenothiazine derivatives, of which chlorpromazine is an outstanding member, Dr. Hollister said this group is used for treating vomiting and increasing the effectiveness of anesthetics and pain-killers as well as being used as tranquilizers.

Complications have been yellow jaundice and a blood disorder characterized by a decrease in white blood cells. Both complications, he mentioned, occur infrequently with no more than one in several thousand patients developing the blood disorder.

**Treat Blood Pressure**  
Rauwolfia drugs, of which reserpine is the most widely known, are employed for treating high blood pressure as well as used for tranquilization, according to the doctor. Gravest complication, he said, has been mental depression which has occasionally led to suicide. These drugs also may aggravate duodenal ulcers and asthma.

Neprobamate, mostly commonly prescribed for simple nervousness and widely known as "Miltown," has the danger of becoming habit forming in some patients, Dr. Hollister reported. He added that, if habit forming occurs and the drug is suddenly withdrawn, symptoms similar to delirium tremens and fits may appear.

Dr. Hollister's observations are based on five years study. Neuro-psychiatric patients mainly are treated at the Palo Alto hospital.

## Federal Subsidy Program Asked To Fight Teen Crime

New York—UPI—Abe Stark, president of the New York City council, today called for an emergency \$100 million a year federal subsidy program to combat teen-age crime and violence.

Stark's appeal to the Senate juvenile delinquency subcommittee was made only a few hours after Bronx police broke up preparations for a gang rumble. They arrested 27 members of the Sinners gang, who had assembled an arsenal including a 20-gauge shotgun, two hunting knives, nine Molotov cocktail bombs and assorted chains.

Deputy Police Inspector James J. Walsh said the Sinners were planning to fight the Valiant Crews gang, which has been on the warpath since one of its members, John Guzman, was slain Monday.

## Record Interest On FHA Loans

Washington—UPI—The highest interest rates in the nation's history on FHA-insured home mortgages went into effect today.

The interest ceiling for one to four-family homes was boosted from 5 1/4 to 5 3/4 per cent Wednesday shortly after President Eisenhower signed a new billion-dollar housing bill passed by Congress.

The FHA also hiked interest rates on other housing programs. Rates on large-scale rental projects were increased from 4 1/2 to 5 1/4 per cent, on cooperatives sales housing from 5 to 5 3/4 per cent, and on co-op rental of management-type housing from 4 1/2 to 5 1/4 per cent.

The legislation signed by the President authorized \$650 million in grants for urban renewal over two years, \$250 million in low-interest loans for construction of college dormitories, \$50 million in loans for housing for the elderly, and \$50 for various other programs.

The 5 3/4 per cent rate on individual home mortgages means that home buyers actually will pay 6 1/4 per cent. This is so because they must pay an additional one-half of 1 per cent insurance premium.

## Buenos Aires Strike Crumples

Buenos Aires—UPI—The City Transportation Workers' Union quit a Communist-Peronist general strike at the halfway point Wednesday night, confirming the near total failure of the walkout.

Jose Pezzimeti, president of the union, broadcast instructions to its members to return to work at midnight, 24 hours after the start of a strike that was to have lasted 48 hours.

Pezzimeti's order appeared to be largely a face-saving gesture. City transportation workers returned to work during the day. By nightfall, service had been restored on nearly all transportation lines.

The walkout was similarly ineffective in most other activities in Buenos Aires proper, but the Peronist-dominated industrial suburbs west and south of the city were shut tight.

## Malheur Hospital Operating in Red

Nyssa—UPI—Improved medical care is putting operation of the Malheur Memorial hospital in the red, according to Manager Charles Smith.

Smith said the hospital has shown a decrease in occupancy during the past two months and generally over the past few years.

He said it apparently has resulted from a reduction in the time patients must remain in hospitals. He said medical and surgical advances are responsible for the shorter amount of time.

**MIGHT NAME STEVENSON**  
Albany, N.Y.—UPI—Mayor Richard J. Daley of Chicago said Wednesday night Adlai E. Stevenson might be named as the Democratic party's presidential candidate next year. Daley said he did not consider himself bound by Stevenson's statement that he would not seek the party nomination a third time.

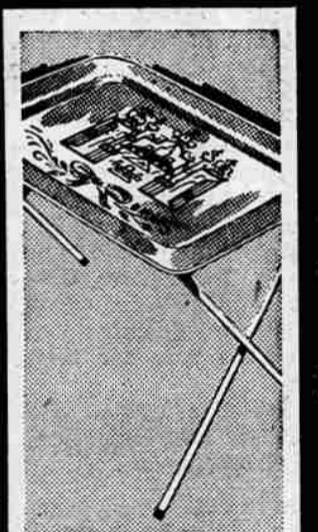

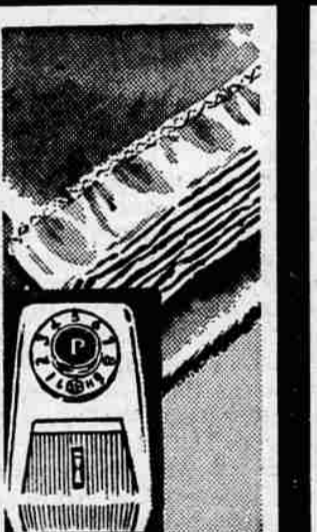
