more to the inborn characteristics of the patient than to his smoking, Dr. A. M. Lilienfeld studied the reports of a census of a group of 1,000 patients with cancer of the lung. Chemotherapy (treatment with drugs) in psychiatry held in Memphis, Tenn., doctors reported on the study of five tranquilizers which were given to 640 patients in 36 V. A. hospitals. The so-called double-blind method was used, in which neither the patients nor the doctors knew which drug was given.

Dr. Alvarez said the adult population of Buffalo in which the groups of cigarette smokers and non-smokers were matched by age, sex, race and social class. This comparison indicated that smokers differ from non-smokers in that more often they marry, they move their residences, they change their jobs, they go to hospitals, and they participate in sports. Any physician of large experience would expect heavy smokers to be nervous persons of the type who greatly crave relief from their inner tensions. As some heavy smokers say, just to be fiddling with something in their fingers helps them greatly. I remember an executive of 40 who, after having been a chain smoker for most of his life was compelled to quit smoking because of serious disease that had started up in his arteries. While in Japan he bought himself a perfect replica, in ivory, of a cigarette, burning it at one end, and he told me that he got comfort from having it always between his fingers.

I am not a philanthropist just because I read this one experience. She told me, she doesn't believe it, but she doesn't believe it.

Louise S. — I just don't believe in a double standard — and I don't think God does either. I have had a religious upbringing, but I also know something about the facts of life. It is perfectly possible for a man to accept the same sexual code women do.

I am so deeply disappointed in John. We had started to go together last year when he had this affair. To think that he could have been carrying on with someone else all the time! It's just too much. I know that plenty of people could agree with John and say "it's different for a man," but I have been taught that it doesn't have to be. I am determined to marry a man who sees this as I do.
