

Sen. Neuberger Disappointed by Seashore Stand

Portland (UPI)—Sen. Richard Neuberger (D-Ore.) said today he was "surprised and disappointed" that Gov. Mark Hatfield's Natural Resources Committee opposed a bill for a National Seashore Recreation park at the Dunes and Sea-Lion Caves near Florence.

Speaking at a luncheon, Neuberger said the decision was "a backward stand which is in conflict with the favorable recommendations not only of the National Parks Advisory committee but also the Oregon State Parks Advisory board."

As a Democratic member of the Senate, Neuberger said, "I am glad to defend the views of the Eisenhower national administration from this unwarranted disagreement by the Hatfield state administration."

Insufficient Study Claimed
The state committee claimed the bill was based on "insufficient study."

Neuberger said he did not understand how a 35,000-acre national park could overburden Oregon with recreation reserves. He said Oregon now has about 160,000 acres in national parks and Washington has 1,200,000 acres in national parks, California, he added, has more than 4,000,000 acres.

"Ex-Congressman Ellsworth opposes my bill because he says it would result in uprooting 250 private homes," Neuberger said.

"Governor Hatfield's committee opposes the bill because it says the land is publicly owned in the park area. Both of them ought to share some of the enlightenment of the Eisenhower national administration, at whose request I have introduced a bill authorizing establishment of three great national seashore recreation areas."

Steel Officials Await Reports

New York (UPI)—Steel strike negotiations were in recess today, the 72nd day of the nationwide walkout, pending reports from negotiations subcommittees.

The subcommittees were meeting to complete their reports for submission to a meeting of the top-level bargaining teams Friday.

Joseph F. Finnegan, director of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, wrote off the deadlocked contract talks as "a frustrating spectacle."

Representatives of the 12 strike-bound steel companies and the United Steelworkers Union met for only 20 minutes Wednesday and 30 minutes the day before. Finnegan said neither side had anything to say to the other.

Friday the top-level negotiating teams will evaluate the findings of their subcommittees which have been discussing non-economic matters and contract language on a company-by-company basis.

Twenty-two Democratic senators told President Eisenhower Wednesday that the strike is "impairing the economic health of the nation." The group, mostly senators from northern and western states, asked Eisenhower to meet with them and governors of steel-producing states to discuss ways of speeding settlement.

State Bar Group Opens Convention

Bend (UPI)—The Oregon State Bar Association opened its 25th annual convention here Wednesday with headquarters at Pilot Butte Inn. Business sessions began this morning in the Tower theater.

Among subjects for consideration in the sessions will be committee reports on tightening of divorce and family relations laws, and protection of rights for a person under arrest.

Walter E. Craig, Phoenix, Ariz., representing the American Bar Association, will speak at a luncheon Friday and discuss lawyers' professional conduct and the judiciary's obligation. He also will give his impression of Russian courts and law. Craig was ABA delegate last year to Russia.

Other speakers include Kline D. Strong, noted Salt Lake City attorney. Chairman of the general committee for the four-day silver anniversary meeting is Dean F. Bryson of Portland.

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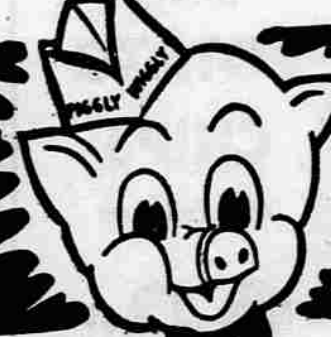
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
