New Vaccines for Polio
Almost from the start of research directed toward the wiping out of polio, it has seemed obvious that the ideal vaccine would be a so-called "live" one which, by producing a mild and harmless form of the disease, should give the child an immunity that would last for many years, or for life. A "killed" vaccine, like the Salk vaccine, is likely to give immunity only for some years; we do not yet know how many. A "live vaccine" is made from what is called an attenuated strain of the virus—a strain so changed and weakened that it can produce immunity, but not serious disease.

In 1798, Dr. William Jenner was given an idea when milkmaids told him that if they contracted "cowpox" from blisters on the udders of their cows, they would never get the smallpox—a disease which in that day used to rage through the world, attacking almost everyone, and disfiguring or killing millions. Jenner started vaccinating people with "cowpox" and within a few years one of the world's greatest scourges was largely conquered. The virus of cowpox was a smallpox virus which had become attenuated and made largely harmless by transmission through the cows.
