Parish Starts Discussion Clubs

The regular fall series of discussion club meetings for the 1959-60 season in Sacred Heart parish is scheduled to begin the week of Oct. 4.

The text to be followed this season is "God Gives His Help," by the Rev. Leo J. Wiese, one of the "This We Believe" series of Confraternity of Christian Doctrine discussion club texts.

Topics which will be studied and discussed in the eight weekly meetings include "The Sacrament of Penance," "Preparing for Confession," "When is Sorrow Real?" "Thank God for Confession," "Telling Our Sins," "Sin and Punishment," "Indulgences," and "Penance Indulgences."

According to Arthur H. Becker, CCD chairman of discussion clubs, 10 or more groups will be active this season with meetings scheduled for many nights of the week, as well as Sunday afternoon and evening.

Some of these groups have room for more members and new clubs of six to twelve persons will be organized as needed so all interested persons may participate in the program.

Although the discussion club is designed primarily to help the Catholic layman, any person not of the Catholic religion is welcome to participate in the meetings.

The groups are kept small and informal. Meetings consist of one hour of discussion, followed by an optional social period, it was reported.
