Portland — (UPI) — The Oregon Centennial definitely ended with black ink on the books.

William Gaarenstroom, Centennial commission fiscal officer, made his report to the commission here Friday and said that although he didn't know yet exactly how much money would be left, there will be some in the coffers. One estimate was \$50,000 or more.

He indicated recently that balancing of books looked promising.

The commission immediately notified the state emergency board and the board commended Centennial officials for "a job well done."

One-Shot Hay-Fever Vaccine

In the May-June number of the Annals of Allergy, Dr. Ethan Allan Brown of Boston, reports that in 1958, when he gave 685 persons (sensitive to ragweed pollen) the one-shot vaccine for hay-fever devised by Dr. Mary Loveless, of New York City, 572 were so well protected that they went through August, September and October comfortably. If this good result can be duplicated by other allergists, it will be wonderful good news for the thousands of persons who now suffer each summer from ragweed hay-fever.

Help for Some Persons With Strokes

The other day, between two addresses I made in Houston, Texas, I had the rare privilege of going through the splendid department of Dr. DeBakey and his associates in the Methodist hospital.

There, every day, they are performing miracles of healing by removing sections of badly diseased and perhaps almost obstructed or almost ruptured arteries and replacing them with sections of strong tubing. One of their miracles that much interested me is their ability in some cases in which a man has JUST had a stroke to find that one of the big arteries in the neck which supplies his brain with blood is more or less plugged-up. When the obstructed place is removed and perhaps a clot is taken out, the man is likely to get much better.

Now, this does not mean that every old person who had a stroke, perhaps some years ago, should be banded up and taken right off to Dr. DeBakey. What it means is that if the patient had a stroke a few days ago and his doctor thinks it worth trying, he might well have what are called angiograms made. A cut is made in the neck and a solution is injected into one of the big arteries. Then an x-ray film is made which will show if the artery is functioning, or if it is plugged-up. If it is plugged, perhaps then it can be opened again.

In good-sized cities there are now specialists who can make angiograms. Already great efforts are being made to work out methods for telling, even without an angiogram, if a neck artery is plugged. Sometimes, if the physician prescribes an open neck artery so that the blood cannot get through it, and the other artery is plugged, the man will immediately black out.

Airman Accused On Dope Charge
